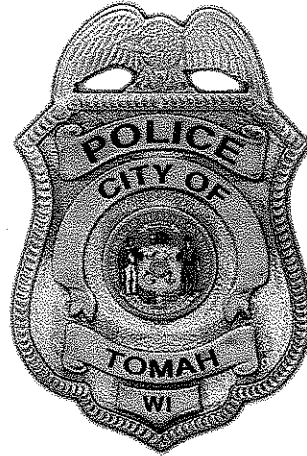

**POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS**

## **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES**

I attended a meeting with representatives of the Our Town Tomah group.

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition

The deadline for application for the part-time Custodial position is December 15, 2010.

The luncheon for the news media is scheduled to take place on December 15, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. in the Community Room at the police department.

The service contract with ServiceMaster has been terminated. The termination is effective January 1, 2011.

Interviews for our vacant part-time clerical position are scheduled for December 22, 2010.

I conducted an Administrative Staff meeting

I attended the Monroe County Budget Public Hearing in November. I made a public request that the monies for the Extension Position be put back into the budget and that the Dispatch Director position not be combined with the Emergency Management position.

I attended the Committee As A Whole and Common Council meetings.

In November, I Chaired my last meeting with the Coulee Region Law Enforcement Executive Group. My year as Chair is up. Chief Kass from the Sparta Police Department will be the Chair in 2011.

I attended the Monroe County (LEPC) Local Emergency Planning Committee Meeting.

I conducted a Command Staff meeting.

## **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of November, 2010 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

Conducted Shift Supervisor duties on many of my scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence assuring proper packaging and identification was affixed.

Managed the filling of open records for video evidence to the public.

Filled video evidence requests from the District Attorney and City Attorney that are used in the prosecution of municipal or circuit court cases.

Managed all schedule-related issues for all sworn department members(comp, vacation, training, special assignment).

Attended Administrative Staff Meeting with Chief Revels, Lieutenant Nicholson, and Administrative Assistant Culpitt.

Attended a meeting with Tomah High School representatives that included discussions about the School Resource Officer, upcoming events, and school safety.

Facilitate MEG supervisor duties (overseeing investigations, request reimbursement, submit monthly stats).

Participated in weapons qualification.

### **SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of November, 2010 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

I completed Evidence Custodian Duties related to the recovery, retention, and disposal of evidence. For the month of November, 138 pieces of evidence were processed into the evidence room.

I attended inter-departmental meetings to include an Administrative Staff Meeting, a Command Staff Meeting, and a meeting to discuss the 2011 Budget.

I attended a meeting held in Sparta for the upcoming, "Parents Who Host Lose the Most" campaign. This program coincides with a grant which we may be applying for again. The grant will cover overtime expenses for officers to conduct compliance checks on alcohol establishments in Tomah.

During the month of November a new squad car arrived. The squad car had been ordered several months ago. Arrangements were made to transfer the equipment from the old squad to the new squad.

I attended two different training sessions; ACISS and Legal Update. ACISS is an internet based program that the Tomah Police Department will be required to use when it conducts narcotics investigations with the MEG unit. ACISS integrates investigative information such as addresses, vehicles, subjects, telephones, financial information, and physical evidence in a format accessible by other narcotics investigators throughout Wisconsin. The Legal Update training was conducted at Fort McCoy and was presented by Assistant Attorney General Dave Perlman.

### **SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER**

Officer Marshall began instructing the G.R.E.A.T. Program in November.

## CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

I attended the weekly Rotary Club meetings.

The Department assisted the Tomah Area Chamber of Commerce with the Holiday Parade.

The G.R.E.A.T. Program is up and running at the Tomah Middle School.

Our annual Holiday Giving Tree is up. We started with 34 names, there are a few left. We receive the names for the tree from Families First.

I'm continuing my Basketball Coaching activities with the Tomah Girl's Junior Varsity Basketball Team. Investigator Walensky coaches youth basketball. Administrative Assistant Culpitt is busy with the performance group, One A chord doing their Holiday performances.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **[10-2365] Public Nuisances – Affecting Morals/Decency**

A Tomah Officer was patrolling the downtown bar district and observed a female subject lying on the sidewalk with two other subjects standing over her. The two subjects were identified as the female subject's friends and they were trying to help her because she was highly intoxicated. The female subject had thrown up twice on the sidewalk and was issued a municipal citation for Public Nuisances.

### **[10-2391] Possession of Marijuana/Probation and Parole Hold**

Tomah Officers conducted a drug investigation that involved a male subject who was purchasing marijuana from the State of Oregon and selling it in Monroe County. This subject was arrested following the investigation and determined to be in possession of 35 grams of Marijuana. The subject has prior drug convictions thus making the charge of Possession of Marijuana a Felony. The male subject was taken to the Monroe County Jail.

### **[10-2411] Possession of Marijuana/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**

A Tomah Officer was conducting follow-up at the Police Department and was speaking with a male subject. This male subject smelled of burnt marijuana and claimed he was not in possession of contraband. K-9 Jager was used to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle belonging to the male subject and K-9 Jager indicated a positive alert. A Probable Cause search was conducted on the vehicle and marijuana was located inside. The investigation continued and led Officer to two different addresses that ultimately produced a smoking device that was used to smoke the marijuana. The male subject was issued citations for Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Obstructing an Officer, for intentionally providing false information to the Police.

**[10-2415] Recklessly Endangering Safety/Disorderly Conduct/Battery**

Tomah Officers met with a male subject at the Tomah Police Department who had been involved in a domestic disturbance. The male subject indicated his girlfriend was intoxicated and had tried to cut his throat during an argument. There was a laceration to the male subject's throat that did not require medical attention. Officers went to the address where the altercation took place and spoke with the female subject. The female subject admitted to possessing the knife during the altercation and also admitted to trying to cut the male subject's throat. The female subject was taken to the Monroe County Jail.

**[10-2464] Battery/Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related**

Tomah Officers received information of a fight that took place behind Dimension's Bar. Officers were being provided information from the victim who was chasing the suspect. Both subjects were located and the investigation revealed that the subject who was running had punched the other in the face. The subject who punched the other was cited for Battery (\$500) and Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related (\$500).

**[10-2466] Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**

Tomah Police received anonymous information involving possible drug activity at a residence on the 100 block of W. Holton St. Officers had contact with several subjects and were given consent to enter and look for contraband. Officers located several items of contraband and were provided items from several subjects. Two of the four subjects were referred to the Monroe County DA's Office and two others were issued Municipal Citations for their respective drug charges.

**[10-2477] Disorderly Conduct/Resisting an Officer**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Kilbourn Ave. for a reported argument outside a residence. An Officer arrived on scene, separated a male and a female subject and began to investigate the disturbance. As the Officer was beginning to interview the male subject he commented that he needed to get home to check on his child. The male subject then turned and fled from the Officer to an address on the 1400 block of Superior Ave. The subject was located and arrested without further incident. The subject was taken to the Monroe County Jail and the female subject was cited for Disorderly Conduct.

**[10-2494] Disorderly Conduct (DAV)/Bail Jumping**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on the 200 block of Sumner St. for a reported domestic disturbance. Officers arrived in the area and located a male subject who matched the description provided by the victim. The male subject indicated that he and the victim were arguing and that he decided to leave. The male subject was intoxicated and currently on bond out of Monroe County for a previous domestic dispute,

with restrictions related to alcohol consumption. The male subject was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct and Bail Jumping. The male subject was also booked for Criminal Damage to Property since he broke the false teeth belonging to the victim during the altercation.
