### **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES**

I attended the Department Head staff meetings with the Mayor and City Administrator.

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition.

### **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of August, 2012 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Attended the Probationary Review Board meeting related to Officer Perkins.

Met with Susan Schwab, a Social Work Associate with the VA Medical Facility, to discuss services available for homeless Veterans.

Assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop off box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 200 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month.

Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

### **COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT**

#### **Call Out:**

No call outs to report in August.

#### **Training:**

Combined Tactical Unit training was conducted on August 7 and consisted of a team meeting, After Action Reviews on the July 18 Rural Manhunt Call Out and the July 19 PATRIOT 2012 Exercise, before heading to the National Night Out event at Winnebago Park. The Combined Tactical Unit has attended National Night Out for several years and conducts a static equipment display as well as a capabilities demonstration. This year the Combined Tactical Unit partnered with the Sparta Police Department K-9 Unit to conduct the capabilities demonstration. The demonstration consisted of a vehicle pursuit scenario by the Sparta Police Department K-9 Unit where one suspect was apprehended by the Sparta Police Department K-9 Unit and the second suspect fled to a hiding location. Combined Tactical Unit personnel with the Tomah Police Department K-9 Unit conducted a search for the suspect and upon locating the suspect utilized Flashbangs and the K-9 to apprehend the suspect. A Combined Tactical Unit sniper team received support from the WI DNR and were deployed via boat ahead of the search team to provide an over watch for the search team.

I assisted the Boys and Girls Club with their "Lemonade Day".

I assisted with the Platoon Run held at the VA.

### INVESTIGATIONS

#### **[12-1635] Substantial Battery, Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers responded to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a battery complaint. Officers arrived and met with a female victim. The female indicated she was at an address on Green Acres Avenue and another female became upset with her and threw a beer bottle at her. The beer bottle struck the victim in the forehead causing a deep laceration. On 8-31-12, Tomah Officers spoke with the suspect and eventually took her into custody for Substantial Battery. The female suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

#### **[12-1656] Bail Jumping – Felony, Possession of Marijuana, Theft from Motor Vehicle**

Tomah Officers received information that a property owner on North Lawrence Street observed someone in their vehicle. The property owner followed the suspects as they fled in a vehicle until Officers stopped it. The investigation revealed that four subjects were driving around and stealing items from vehicles. All four subjects were identified but two of them had fled the scene as the property owner confronted them. The two remaining suspects, both females, spoke with Officers and one of them provided false information. This female subject was arrested and taken to jail. The remaining female suspect will be referred to the Monroe County District Attorney. The remaining two suspects, both males, fled on foot but were identified. One of these suspects is wanted in the City of Sparta for a recent home invasion and is known to be responsible for numerous vehicle entries and thefts.

**[12-1673] Disorderly Conduct – Alcohol related/Physical**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on Murdock Street for a reported disturbance. The investigation revealed that an intoxicated male subject had gone to an apartment with the intent of obtaining pornographic movies from one of the occupants. While the intoxicated male was inside the apartment he allegedly made sexual advances towards a female. When the intoxicated male was leaving he slapped the female numerous times on her arm and kissed her. The intoxicated male subject was contacted and cited for his conduct.

**[12-1675] Substantial Battery, Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Dimensions Bar for a disturbance. A Tomah Officer arrived on scene and discovered a male subject who was bleeding profusely from his mouth. The investigation revealed that two male subjects got into a fight over a female. The male subject that was still at the bar, and bleeding profusely, was knocked unconscious and struck repeatedly about the head and face area and then kicked in the face. Officers were able to identify the male suspect that fled the scene. The male suspect that was bleeding was taken to the hospital where a Doctor determined the extent of his injuries would require an ENT specialist. This subject was not taken to jail due to his injuries and instead was taken to La Crosse, Wisconsin by an ambulance. The other involved subject will be located, arrested and taken to jail.

**[12-1676] Recklessly Endangering Safety, Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers responded to an address on Heeler Avenue for a report of a male subject threatening others with a knife. Officers arrived, located the suspect, and he was taken into custody at gun point without any further incident. The investigation revealed the suspect was highly intoxicated and had been dropped off at the apartment. Shortly after being dropped off, the suspect began screaming about someone shooting him. The male suspect chased several people around the apartment while he was in possession of three knives. A female victim was able to punch the suspect in the face causing him to drop the knives but this did not deter the suspect from continuing to try and attack the occupants. Police arrived quickly and took the suspect into custody. No one was injured by the suspect's actions.
