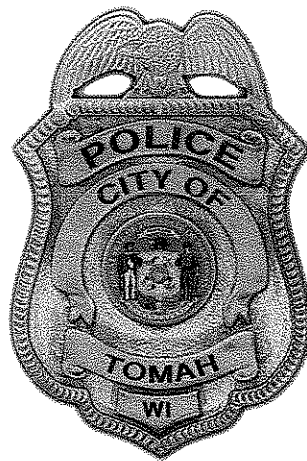


# **TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**August 2010 Report**

**POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS**

### **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES:**

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition.

I met with Tom Johnson, the new part-time employee that was hired by the West Central MEG Unit. Johnson is a retired Investigator from Vernon County. He will be responsible for coordinating information sharing and resources for the member Counties of the MEG Unit that includes Monroe, Jackson, La Crosse, Vernon and Trempeleau Counties.

I attended Departmental training at the HREF (High Risk Entry Facility) facility in Camp Douglas.

The Police Department held a meeting with other City Departments for the purpose of determining what each Department needs related to the 2013 Interoperability Communications requirements. It was decided that Lt. Nicholson would coordinate a communication "evaluation" with Motorola.

I attended a meeting of the Tomah Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association.

We held a meeting with some of the City of Tomah tavern owners and representatives of the Monroe County Tavern League. The meeting went well. We continue to discuss concerns related to the Downtown. Our level of cooperation with a majority of the tavern owners has improved substantially. We also discussed the cigarette butt litter problem that we anticipated coming up after the legislative change to the Indoor Smoking Laws. The owners at the meeting indicated that they would work toward resolving the littering.

Lieutenant's Nicholson and Waddell organized an auction that was held on August 25<sup>th</sup>.

The Department assisted with the annual Platoon Run Parade from Recreation Park to the Veterans Administration grounds.

I met with the City of Tomah Police and Fire Commission. Sergeant Chris Weaver completed the second portion of a Use of Force presentation at the meeting.

I met with representatives of the Salvation Army.

I met with Judge Flock and Chief Obong from the VA for the purpose of discussing the Veteran's Court Initiative that Judge Flock had heard about at his Municipal Judge's training conference.

### **TRAINING**

All Sworn members of the Department attended training at the High Risk Entry Facility (HREF). The training consisted of room searches and high risk entries. The HREF facility is operated by Northeast Counterdrug Training Center (NCTC).

Members of the Department received updated information from District Attorney Dan Cary related to court ordered subpoenas.

Sworn members of the Department received training on immediate care for Field Trauma.

Officer Kenworthy and Marshall attended the Governor's Conference on Highway Safety.

Investigator Walensky and Officer Jones attended the Wisconsin Narcotics Officer Association Conference.

Officer Kenworthy attended Hostage Negotiation training.

### **CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

I attended the Fort McCoy Business Appreciation Night at Fort McCoy.

The 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Monroe County National Night Out was held in August.

I appeared on the WBOG Morning Mix Radio program.

We worked cooperatively with the Tomah Journal on articles related to our training on high risk building entries, our Field Training Officer Program and the increase in fines for Alcohol Related Disorderly Conduct that results in punches being thrown.

Administrative Assistant Culpitt and the Dog Ordinance Committee completed their work on the dog ordinances. The information will be presented at the September Common Council meeting for Council member review.

Lieutenant's Waddell and Nicholson participated in the Parks and Recreation sponsored Cannonball contest.

Officer Marshall conducted a safety presentation to a group of young people at the request of representatives of the Lake Tomah Clinic.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **[10-1650] Substantial Battery, Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related**

Tomah Officers were on foot patrol in the down town bar district when they observed a fight in front of Dimensions Bar. As Officers were attempting to intervene a male subject punched another male subject in the face knocking him unconscious. Officers immediately summonsed medical treatment for the subject that was lying unconscious on the sidewalk. A Tomah Officer deployed his department issued Electronic Control Device (ECD) and fired it at the aggressive male subject, who was still trying to fight other patrons. The ECD was effective and allowed the Officers to take this subject into custody without any further incident. During this chaotic scene, that was in the middle of 75-100 citizens, a male subject walked towards Officers in the street and refused to stop even after being verbally instructed to several times. This male subject then turned around, pulled his pants down and "mooned" the Tomah Officers as well as the male subject that had been taken into custody. This action energized the crowd and was creating an even more chaotic scene for Officers to handle. This subject was also taken into custody. The male subject that punched the other was referred to the Monroe County District Attorney with felony Battery charges. The male subject that entered the street and lowered his britches was cited for Disorderly Conduct and released.

### **[10-1671] Bail Jumping**

Tomah Officers observed a female subject near the Tomah Police Department district that appeared intoxicated. Officers recognized this female subject and knew she was on bond with 'no-drink' conditions. Officer subsequently had contact and determined the female subject was in fact violating her Monroe County bond conditions. The female subject was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

### **[10-1699] Underage Consumption of Alcohol, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Warrant**

A Tomah Officer was on patrol in the downtown bar district and observed three subjects near the Break Room Bar. These three subjects saw the Officer traveling in the area and quickly began walking in the opposite direction. The Officer believed this behavior was suspicious and also believed the three subjects were under the age of twenty-one. The Officer had contact with the three of them and determined that they all were under the age of twenty-one and all had been consuming alcohol. Two of the subjects had warrants for their arrest and were taken into custody. One of the subjects that were taken into custody informed the Officer that he possessed marijuana and a smoking device. The subjects were issued citations for the alcohol violations and the two with warrants were transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[10-1761] Knowingly Fleeing an Officer, Recklessly Endangering Safety, Disorderly Conduct, Battery, Reckless Driving**

Tomah Officers were in the downtown bar district when they observed a motorcycle leave from in front of Dimensions Bar at a high rate of speed. Officers pursued the motorcycle and it refused to stop. The motorcycle proceeded into Juneau County and its speed was registered at 147 mph by a Juneau County Deputy. Tomah Officers interviewed several subjects and were able to determine that the male subject that fled from Officers had been involved in a Domestic Violence related incident just prior to leaving. The male subject turned himself in to Police the following day and was at his court appearance the same day.

**[10-1768] Violation of Bar Closing Hours**

A Tomah Officer observed several subjects inside Callahan's Bar after closing hours. The subjects were all contacted and two of them had opened and partially consumed alcoholic beverages in front of them and were making no attempt to leave. The bar tender wasn't ushering anyone out of the establishment and wasn't too concerned that the Police were there trying to enforce the bar closing hours. The Officer verified that this bartender was not new and was aware of the laws pertaining to closing hours. There were two female subjects inside the bar that initially claimed to be employed there and were cleaning up. Once the Officer mentioned calling the bar owner these two both indicated they weren't employed there and left. The bartender was ultimately cited for this violation and released.

**COMMENDATIONS**

I want to thank Jessica Larson and the Tomah Journal for the emphasis that is currently being placed on getting information related to law enforcement services in the newspaper. I've heard many positive comments regarding the increase in coverage.
