SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

Possession of Marijuana. While investigating a theft from a locker the suspect student was found to be in possession of Marijuana. Cited municipally for Theft and Possession of Marijuana.

Officer Sloan and Officer Marshall responded to Lemonweir School for an out of control student, who was throwing chairs. The student was defiant and refused to listen. Student

was secured in handcuffs and removed from the school. The student was later released to a relative.

During the month of April Officer Marshall met with teen mothers and presented information in regards to car seat safety.

Officer Marshall attended Child Development Day and presented safety information.

Officer Marshall met with the high school health classes in regards to violence.

Officer Marshall and Lieutenant Nicholson took students from Robert Kupper Learning Center to lunch at McDonald's as part of Community Pride.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

I met with Eric Prise, from the Tomah Memorial Hospital. Eric requested comments from me for a newspaper article that he authored. The article promoted the Prescription Drug Drop Off Event.

I attended the ground breaking ceremony for the new Toro Manufacturing Distribution Center.

I attended a media event along with Eric Prise and Jan Path from Tomah Memorial Hospital. We were interviewed by a TV station for the purpose of promoting the Prescription/Unwanted Medication Drop Off Event.

I coordinated clean up of the downtown area for the Our Town Tomah group. Representatives from several businesses assisted along twenty-five students from Roots and Shoots. The Monroe County Community Services Unit also helped out.

The Prescription Drug/Unwanted Medication Event was held on April 22, Earth Day.

INVESTIGATIONS

[10-0641] Substantial Battery, Battery, Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Officers were on foot patrol in the downtown bar district. Officers were informed by the owner of Dimensions Bar that a disturbance had just occurred inside and one of the subjects had been knocked unconscious. Officers were able to locate the suspect as well as tend to the victim and summons appropriate medical care. The suspect admitted

to punching the victim and did so because he believed the victim was hitting on his girlfriend. The suspect was taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-0643] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the downtown bar district for a report of two female subjects fighting in the street. Officers arrived on scene and observed two females wrestling with each other in a lane of traffic. The victim and witnesses indicated the suspect approached the victim, punched her several times and then began to wrestle into the street. The suspect was cited for Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related and released.

[10-0655] Burglary/Possessing Stolen Property/Possession of Marijuana/Criminal Trespass to Dwelling

Tomah Officers investigated a burglary complaint on the 300 block of John St. The victims had numerous items taken. The victims provided the name of a suspect and supplied information pertaining to the items stolen, which were valued at over \$2,000. The victims secured the trash bags from the suspect's yard and located items that belonged to them. The Tomah Police applied for a search warrant and were granted one to search the property of the suspect. During the execution of the search warrant Officers located several items that were reported stolen. The suspect was located and interviewed. The suspect admitted to the burglary and was able to return the majority of the stolen items.

[10-0749] Child Enticement/Exposing Genital to Child/Sexual Assault to Child by School Staff or Person that Works with a Child/Sexual Exploitation of a Child The Tomah Police Department was made aware of an allegation that a City of Tomah business owner had inappropriately touched and taken nude pictures of a 17-year-old child. The investigation revealed that a male subject did in fact touch the child inappropriately and also had taken a picture of the child's naked private area. The suspect was interviewed and subsequently taken into custody for the alleged crimes. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-0780] Traffic-Knowingly Flee an Officer/Recklessly Endangering Safety/Possession of Marijuana/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/Violation of Absolute Sobriety

A Tomah Officer was actively patrolling the southern portion of the City of Tomah and turned around to check on a vehicle. When the Officer turned around a vehicle ahead of the Officer began to drive erratically and at a high rate of speed. The Officer began to pursue the vehicle and shortly there after was engaged in a high-speed pursuit. The vehicle eventually stopped in a driveway on Williams St. and the operator fled on foot. Tomah Officer were able to locate the suspect who indicated he ran because he was having problems with his girlfriend. The suspect was taken into custody, processed for Violation of Absolute Sobriety and taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-0781] Carrying a Concealed Weapon/Probation and Parole Hold

Tomah Officers responded to the west alley area on the 200 block of Superior Ave for a reported disturbance. Officers located a male subject who was acting very nervous and was favoring his front pocket. Officer conducted a pat down search for weapons and located a pistol in the suspect's front pants pocket. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-0114] Manufacture-Deliver Controlled Substance/Possession of Cocaine w/ Intent/Various other drug charges

During an on-going drug investigation personnel from the Tomah Police Department and the Monroe County Sheriff's Department observed an exchange of money for cocaine in a business parking lot in the 1100 block of N. Superior Ave. in the City of Tomah. Tomah Police and Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel conducted a traffic stop on the involved vehicles and subsequently arrested MICHAEL KINGSLEY for delivery of cocaine. During his arrest KINGSLEY was found to be in possession of more cocaine and marijuana.

In furtherance of this investigation officers applied for and received a search warrant for KINGSLEY'S residence at 124 E. Veterans St. Apartment 2 in the City of Tomah.

During this investigation law enforcement seized the following from KINGSLEY: 59 Oxycodone pills with an estimated street value of \$1770, 129 grams of Cocaine with an estimated street value of at least \$4000, 428 grams of marijuana with an estimated street value of at least \$1500, and \$3054 in US Currency. KINGSLEY was booked at the Monroe County Jail

[10-0850] Death Investigation

This case involves a death investigation at 316 Woodard Avenue in Tomah on 4-27-2010. The Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory assisted with the scene investigation on 4-27-2010. The Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory assisted with the autopsy investigation on 4-28-2010.

COMMENDATIONS

The Unwanted Medication Drop Off Event took place on April 22, 2010. In partnership with Tomah Memorial Hospital, this event was once again very successful. Over 142 pounds of pills and 82 pounds of other medications were dropped off. This event was facilitated by Lieutenant Nicholson and Administrative Assistant Rhonda Culpitt. Jan Path and Eric Prise from TMH assisted with this event, together with members of the Departments VIPS (Volunteers in Police Services); America Fushianes, Joyce Stenklyft, Fran Pollard, Carrie Todhunter and Dale Chitwood.

A "Thank You" goes out to all members of the Department for their work with the ongoing death investigation that the Department is presently handling. All members of the Department have pulled together to assist in whatever manner needed.
