CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

INVESTIGATIONS

[12-0658] Possession of a Synthetic Cannabinoid, Bail Jumping-Felony, Warrant Arrest

Tomah Officers responded to an address on North Street to try and locate a subject with a warrant. Officers arrived, knocked on the door and were told to enter. Once inside the Officers asked for the wanted subject and the wanted subject soon appeared. During this contact another person inside the residence was known to Officers and was wanted by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. Both subjects were taken into custody. While Officers were taking the subjects into custody synthetic cannabinoid was located inside the residence. Both subjects were taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[12-0663] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-3rd offense

A Tomah Officer observed a vehicle at a business at 2:30AM. The vehicle was stopped and the investigation revealed that a passenger in this vehicle had driven the car to the business and had car problems. The operator of that vehicle was intoxicated and arrested for OWI. The operator submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .19 BAC.

[12-0669] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated

A Tomah Officer was patrolling in the area of Recreation Park when a vehicle was observed spinning in circles on the gravel area. The vehicle was stopped and the operator was arrested for OWI. The operator submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .134 BAC.

[12-0710] Possession of Psilocybin, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Drug Warehouse

Tomah Officers received information that a male subject was given psilocybin mushrooms. Officers had contact with the suspect and the suspect admitted to possessing psilocybin mushrooms ('shrooms'). A subsequent search of the suspect's residence revealed additional items of contraband. The suspect will be charged with numerous drug related charges.

[12-0718] Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Minor Transporting Alcohol, Underage Alcohol Consumption, Operating After Suspension

Tomah Officers overheard radio traffic from the Wisconsin State Patrol concerning a possible drug transaction that occurred in Oakdale, Wisconsin. The vehicle was located in the City of Tomah and stopped. The investigation revealed the operator of the vehicle was in possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The operator and a couple passengers had also been consuming alcohol. All parties were cited and released.
