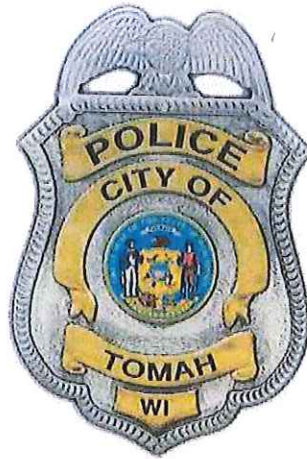


# TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT

**August 2013 Report**

### **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of August, 2013 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

- I assumed command of the department due to the retirement of Chief Wesley Revels.
- I attended the monthly Committee of Whole and City Council meetings.
- I attended the Monroe County Local Emergency Planning Committee meeting.
- I attended the Monroe County Safety Coalition Alcohol Workgroup meeting.
- I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.
- I assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.
- I monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 140 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month. I monitored and processed dispositions of cases in which evidence is to be disposed of.
- I managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.
- I assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.
- I attended bi-weekly meetings with the other Department Supervisors.

### **SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of August, 2013 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

- I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.
- Building maintenance needs continue to be addressed, to include discussions about future service contracts. Provided oversight during repairs to the HVAC, learned/observed the process of monthly operation of the building generator.

Fleet maintenance oversight continues with scheduled and unscheduled repairs. Together with Sgt. Huneck, the budget proposal for replacement squads has been researched and submitted for addition to the 2014 Police Department Budget.

Lieutenant Nicholson and I continue to provide oversight with all items related to the evidence room, to include incoming and outgoing evidence, copying of evidence CD's and DVD's.

Attended a Financial Institute Security Officer Association (F.I.S.O.A.) meeting, which was held at First Bank. Items of discussion included current trends in scam/fraud efforts most commonly appearing at the local institutes. The group welcomed FBI Special Agent Andy John and discussed recent counterfeit cases. Also mentioned the most recent fraud efforts the FBI is seeing are the Phishing (e-mail fraud) and secret shopper paycheck scams.

Assisted with the annual Platoon Run. Organized officers and participated with the escort of the Platoon Run from Recreation Park to the VA. Appeared to be approximately 200 participants (cars, trucks, and motorcycles).

Attended a meeting with Tomah School Administrators, Tomah Fire Chief Kevin Decorah, and Parks and Recreation Director Joe Protz. The meeting covered very recent updates to the Comprehensive School Safety Guide, which covered emergency planning, prevention, and response.

### **COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT**

Combined Tactical Unit Monthly Report-August 2013

Training – The CTU monthly training was conducted in conjunction with the Monroe County National Night Out. The training included a demonstration for those that attended National Night Out. The demonstration consisted of vehicle pursuit which concluded when 2 subjects exited their vehicle and fled into a bus with children and the bus driver. The tactical team conducted an entry onto the bus to apprehend the suspects and evacuate the students and bus driver. After the demonstration the tactical unit spoke with those that attended National Night Out, answering questions that they had and displaying their tactical equipment to them.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **[13-1381] Methamphetamine Paraphernalia, Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers responded to the downtown bar area for a report of a male and female fighting. Officers met with both of the subjects and determined they had equal involvement in the altercation and were arrested for Disorderly Conduct. The female subject had a used hypodermic needle on her person that she claimed was used for injecting Methamphetamine. Both subjects were transported to the Monroe County Jail.

### **[13-1394] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia**

A Tomah Officer observed a vehicle traveling on the North Superior Avenue in the wrong lanes. The vehicle was stopped and the operator was determined to be intoxicated. The operator was administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and was determined to be impaired. The operator was arrested. A search of the vehicle revealed marijuana, a smoking device and an opened can of beer. The operator refused to submit to an evidentiary chemical test of her breath and was subsequently transported to the Monroe County Jail.

### **[13-1398] Burglary**

Tomah Officers were investigating two separate burglaries; one at a business and another at a residence. The burglary at the business involved the theft of a large amount of liquor and the burglary at the residence involved the theft of numerous firearms. A Tomah Investigator went to an address on East Council Street and spoke with several subjects. The Tomah Investigator was able to determine that the majority of the property from both burglaries was at this residence. A male subject was later located and interviewed regarding the stolen firearms. This person is a convicted felon and was taken to the Monroe County Jail. Additional charges will be forthcoming.

### **[13-1405] Substantial Battery**

Tomah Officers were summoned to Tomah Memorial Hospital to meet with a male subject who had been involved in a physical altercation at the Bank Bar. Officers met with the male subject and noted that he had substantial injuries to his head that included numerous deep lacerations. The subject indicated he got into an argument with another male bar patron and this person struck him in the head with a beer bottle. Officers later spoke with the bartender, who didn't alert the Police of this altercation, and learned that both men were engaged in an argument and both tried hitting the other with bottles. Charges will be referred to the Monroe County District Attorney's Office.

### **[13-1417] Obstructing an Officer, Bail Jumping, Operating After Suspension, Reckless Driving**

A Tomah Officer observed a vehicle being operated near Butts Avenue and Fair Street. The vehicle eluded the Officer and was located on the 1500 block of Lincoln Avenue. The operator of the vehicle fled from the scene. The operator was located at Kwik Trip South after an anonymous call of a male subject talking on the phone. The anonymous caller indicated the male subject told someone on the phone that 'they' were looking for him. Officers had contact with a male subject who was sweaty; similar to

someone who had ran several blocks. This subject has been known to accompany the registered owner of the vehicle and had been in a relationship with the owner. The subject provided false information to the Police and was arrested for Obstructing. The subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

Investigator Walensky attended a training conference hosted by the Wisconsin Narcotics Officer Association.
