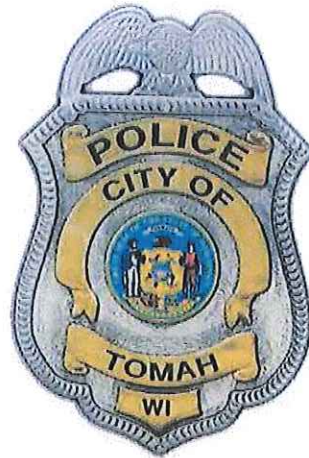

December 2013 Report

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of December, 2013 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

I assumed command of the department due to the retirement of Chief Wesley Revels.

I attended the monthly Committee of Whole meeting.

I attended a meeting at the Tomah VA Hospital to discuss with other community shareholders options for VA patients who are homeless or in need of other services which the VA has to offer.

I completed requests made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. I managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

I assisted the City Administrator in setting up and scheduling the pre-employment testing for a future Chief of Police. Those tests included psychological testing, audio testing, visual testing, drug screening, and physical agility testing. These tests were scheduled to take place at Martin McAllister in Minneapolis and at the Tomah Memorial Hospital. Included in this were scheduling airline tickets, a rental vehicle, and a motel room.

I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

I assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

I monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 126 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month. I monitored and processed dispositions of cases in which evidence is to be disposed of.

I managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments. I facilitated the shift selection process and vacation selection process for the patrol and supervisory staff for the upcoming year.

I assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

I attended bi-weekly meetings with the other Department Supervisors.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of December, 2013 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

Reviewed open record request and completed required redactions and other duties related.

I hosted a Financial Institution Security Officers Association (F.I.S.O.A.) meeting here at the police department

I assisted with the copying of open records requests for DVD, VHS, and Compact Discs as needed.

I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

I monitored the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department, which averages a full box every 1.5 weeks of unused, unwanted, or expired medications

I monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence as needed. The evidence responsibilities also required return of evidence and limited destruction of evidence as time permitted. Evidence was provided to officers for follow-up and/or turn over to other police agencies.

Fleet maintenance oversight continues with scheduled and unscheduled repairs.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Combined Tactical Unit Monthly Report-December, 2013

CALLOUTS:

12/24/13: Tomah Police Department requested Combined Tactical Unit (CTU) assistance with serving a search warrant for stolen firearms on E. Milwaukee St. Tomah Police Department personnel had attempted to contact the occupants of an upstairs duplex and the occupants refused to speak with the police. Tomah Police obtained a search warrant for the residence and requested CTU assistance. CTU personnel responded and over the next two hours all five of the occupants of the residence were convinced to exit the residence and were detained. CTU then entered the residence and conducted a search for any other hidden suspects. No other suspects were located and the scene was turned over to Tomah Police Department.

TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT TACTICAL CALL OUT:

12/17/13: Tomah Police Department personnel responded to an address in the 1700 block of Superior Ave. in regards to a subject who had told a social worker that she had a gun and was going to kill herself. Tomah Police Department CTU personnel were at the Tomah Police Department preparing to travel to Sparta for scheduled CTU training and responded to assist. Tomah Police Department CTU personnel formed a contact team and detained the subject when she was convinced to exit the residence. After the subject was detained and turned over to Tomah Police Department personnel CTU members conducted a protective sweep of the residence and did not locate anyone else inside.

TRAINING REVIEW:

Training was conducted in Sparta and coordinated by Sparta Police Department Officer Nelson. In addition to serving as a police officer, Officer Nelson is also an EMT and Team Leader / Tactical Medic for CTU. The initial portion of the training was classroom lecture regarding tactical EMS (self aid/buddy aid). After the classroom lecture practical building clearing training was conducted at an unoccupied business location in Sparta. This business provided office space as well as warehouse space to conduct various building clearing exercises including officer down rescue and use of ballistic shields.

INVESTIGATIONS

[13-2051] **Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon, Disorderly Conduct**
Tomah Officers responded to an address on Evergreen Pass regarding a male subject who had pulled a gun on another. Additionally, Officers were informed the other subjects were able to wrestle the gun

away from the suspect. Three male subjects had been consuming alcohol in downtown Tomah. They went to an address on Evergreen Pass and all three went inside as they were all friends. Two of the subjects exited the residence to smoke a cigarette. Upon returning inside they heard the slide of a pistol and located their friend in the hallway. The friend pointed the firearm at them and then retreated to a bedroom and returned without it. The two friends subdued the third until the Police arrived. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-2062] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-1st offense, Resisting an Officer, Accident, Failure to Report Accident, Reckless Driving

Tomah Officer investigated a hit and run involving a dark colored Chevy car. Officers ultimately located the vehicle after it had struck a power pole near Lake Tomah on Parkview Dr. The suspect had fled on foot and was located by an Officer walking across an open snowy field. The suspect was transported to the Tomah Police Department for testing related to suspicion of Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated. The suspect was ultimately arrested but refused to cooperate and instead decided to fight. The suspect was controlled with the assistance of an Electronic Control Device and taken into custody. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-2103] Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon, Disorderly Conduct with Dangerous Weapon, Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Officers responded to an address on the 1100 block of Superior Ave. for an armed subject. Officers learned a male subject had armed himself with a knife and threatened to kill anyone that came near him. Officers located the suspect and took him into custody while at gun point. The suspect had cut his mother as she attempted to take the knife from him. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-2119] Theft of Firearm, Theft, Felon in Possession of Firearm, CTU Callout and Probation hold

On Christmas Eve morning a Tomah Officer was dispatched to an address on Williams St. for a report of a theft. The Officer arrived and learned that several firearms and ammunition had been stolen. The Officer observed footprints in the area that were believed to be directly linked to the theft. The Officer traced the footprints to an address on the 200 block of E. Milwaukee St. The footprints appeared to enter an upstairs apartment. The Officer began surveillance on the apartment while other Officers began gathering information in anticipation of obtaining a search warrant. Tomah Officers were familiar with this residence from numerous prior Police contacts. Several Officers attempted contact but only heard people inside and no one answered the door. Based on the probable chance the suspects and firearms were at this location the Monroe County Combined Tactical unit was activated and responded to the scene. A total of five people were eventually taken into custody. Two of these subjects were brought to the Tomah Police Department, read their constitutional rights and were interviewed. Both subjects admitted to their involvement in the theft of the firearms. Both subjects were transported to the Monroe County Jail. A third subject from the residence will be referred to the District Attorney's Office for Obstructing an Officer (This subject knowingly provided false information to the Police).
