OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

This month saw a large volume of medications being dropped in the lobby repository, which were then removed and secured for safekeeping and future disposal. The next planned National Take Back date is April 27, 2013 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Due to the overwhelming amounts that have been brought into the police department, Administrative Assistant Culpitt will be organizing volunteers to help organize and discard the medications currently being held.

Participation in an expanded District Facilities Meeting, with a focus on evaluating current building safety practices, then recommending changes where appropriate.

I attended the second Financial Institution Security Officers Association (F.I.S.O.A.) meeting. There were additional discussions about a spring and fall training for all institution employees that would include providing security updates by the Tomah Police Department.

Evidence room oversight to include incoming and outgoing evidence, copying of evidence CD's and DVD's. One case of interest allowed us (via an evidence release from the District Attorney) to release hundreds of items back to the victim in a major theft case. The removal of this case from the evidence room has opened up a complete wall of shelving.

Facilitated the backgrounds and scheduling of a ride-along request.

Training:

February training was conducted on 02/19/13 in Sparta and consisted of classroom training on search warrant planning, a practical search warrant exercise and practical building clearing exercise at Lawrence-Lawson Elementary School in Sparta. Officer Nelson obtained the use of a house near Union-National Bank for the search warrant exercises. Two groups each planned a search warrant service on the house based on information provided. Both groups selected different tactics for serving the search warrant and as a team we discussed the pros and cons of each plan. We then conducted the simulated search warrant service, including an unanticipated officer down component, at the house in live time. Then we moved to the school where we debriefed the search warrant service and then discussed the school scenario before conducting a practical exercise at the school involving the search for an armed suspect from a domestic violence incident.

The Tomah Police Department and Tomah Area School District sponsored a luncheon for the School Crossing Guards in celebration of National School Crossing Guard Week.

INVESTIGATIONS

Case #13-209 OWI and Drug Possession

Vehicle stopped about two to three vehicle lengths behind the red stop light on West Jackson Street facing east. Observed that this vehicle had a defective driver's side headlamp and damage to the driver's side front headlamp area. Spoke with the driver and asked for him to exit the vehicle. Explained to him that officer wanted to conduct field sobriety testing on him to make sure he was safe to be driving. Once arrested for OWI-1st, a search of his person produced six (6) loose pills later identified as a schedule III narcotic drug. Also located an opened can of Ice House beer underneath the driver seat. The driver was cited municipally for OWI-1st and PAC. He was also cited municipally for No Insurance. The driver is being referred to the Monroe County District Attorney's Office for Possession of Schedule III Narcotic Drug.

Case # 13-240 Bailjumping

Victim stated that on Saturday, February 9, 2013, at approximately 2:00 pm, she was in the bathroom. The victim's daughter started banging on the bathroom door commenting that she was seeing ghosts. Victim stated that a neighbor heard the banging from the main entrance to the apartment building and came to victim's front door. Victim answered the door and opened it half way. Victim stated that the neighbor "pushed his way into my apartment" without consent. Victim stated that the neighbor intentionally grabbed her breast with his whole hand. Victim stated that she felt "nasty and violated" by this action but was Victim stated that she felt uncomfortable having neighbor in the apartment due to previous encounters with him. Victim stated that she began to cry and told the neighbor that she needed to be quiet to not disturb the neighbors. Neighbor was arrested and booked into the Monroe County Jail on the charges of Bailjumping, Criminal Trespass to a Dwelling and Disorderly Conduct. Request of the District Attorney's Office to consider a charge of 4th Degree Sexual Assault as well.

Case #13-25 Operating a Motor Vehicle w/ Restricted Controlled Substance and Possession of Marijuana.

Officer conducted a traffic stop on a motor vehicle on Highway 21 just outside of the city limits for speeding. The officer smelled an odor of marijuana while speaking to the driver. The driver indicated that there was a pipe and bag of marijuana in the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle was later arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Restricted Controlled Substance and cited with a county ordinance for Possession of Marijuana. The passenger also received a citation for Possession of Marijuana.

Case #13-257 Possession of Marijuana at the Middle School

Officer received a call from an employee of Tomah Middle School requesting assistance with a drug case and subsequent searches. Officer arrived at the Tomah Middle School and made contact with the principal. The principal showed the officer a bag of marijuana and indicated he had received reports from students that another student was in possession of marijuana. This student got the marijuana from another student who had gotten it from his older brother. One of the students purchased the bag of marijuana from an unidentified person at the park the night before for \$20.00. The two students were cited for Possession of Marijuana.

Case #13-268 4th Degree Sexual Assault, Bailjumping and Warrant Arrest

Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at Dimension's Tavern. Investigation revealed that suspect was in the tavern and had grabbed a female patron's breasts before throwing her to the ground and fighting with other patrons. Suspect was located and provided false identification information to police. Suspect was arrested and found to have two active bonds and an arrest warrant from Jackson County. Suspect was transported to Monroe County Jail.

Case #13-275 Battery and Disorderly Conduct

Officers were assigned to a fight in progress at Walmart Supercenter in Tomah. Walmart employees were getting third hand information about a physical fight on the grocery side at the store. According to a victim, they were all walking out of the store when a group of individuals in front of them just turned around and attacked them. Further information was gathered by the officers and they learned that the suspect asked the victim to step outside. As they were walking out of the store, the suspect attacked the victim and an uninvolved friend of the victim, got struck as well. The suspect was cited for Disorderly Conduct and Battery.

Case #13-280 False Imprisonment, Felony Bailjumping, Disorderly Conduct, Possession of K-2 and Paraphernalia, Intimidation of a Victim and Resisting Arrest

Officers were dispatched to a domestic abuse incident in progress at 1100 block of East Brownell Street and no radio traffic was used due to the suspect having a scanner. The

officer was aware of the suspect's domestic violent history and knew that he recently strangled his wife and is currently on felony bond out of Monroe County. The suspect resisted several of the officer's attempts to be taken into custody so he was eventually tasered, taken to the hospital for medical treatment and then to jail. The suspect was charged with Felony Bailjumping, False Imprisonment, Intimidation of a Victim, Resisting an Officer, Disorderly Conduct and Possession of K-2 and Paraphernalia.

Case # 13-283 Domestic Disturbance

The victim reported that approximately twelve hours earlier, the victim had gotten into a domestic incident. The victim went to bed by the suspect; the suspect pushed her and then punched the victim approximately six times. The victim told police that this happens almost daily and the suspect has threatened to kill the victim if the victim leaves. Police located the suspect at his residence but the suspect had barricaded himself in his room. The room was sprayed with OC spray and eventually the suspect was arrested. The suspect was charged with Failure to Comply with Officers, Battery, Disorderly Conduct and Resisting an Officer.

Case #13-304 OMVWI, Reckless Driving, Hit and Run

Officers were dispatched to reported Hit and Run crash at the intersection of West Foster Street and Hollister Avenue. Dispatch advised the suspect fled on foot northbound on Hollister. The suspect was located at his residence and field sobriety tests were performed. The suspect was arrested for the following OWI -1st, Failure to Notify Police of Accident, Hit and Run to an Unattended Vehicle, Reckless Driving, Seatbelt Violation and Unsafe Lane Deviation.

Case #13-315 Child Neglect

A nurse at the hospital reported to police concerns regarding an infant. Monroe County Human Services were contacted and are conducting further follow-up in this case.

Case #13-324 Fraud

A victim came to the police department to report that someone had used her debit card without her permission. The investigation revealed that a former boyfriend and roommate is the suspect in this case. The total amount of loss for the victim is \$2398.64. This investigation continues.
