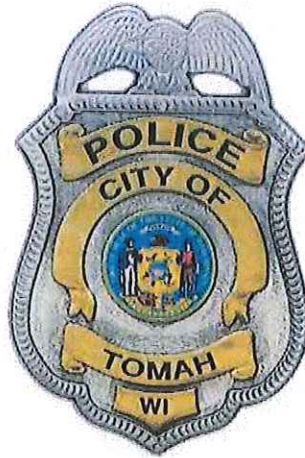

February 2014 Report

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

I attended the monthly Committee of Whole meeting.

I attended a joint sharing session with the Tomah School District, Monroe County Human Services, and the Tomah Police Department. This meeting was established based upon a need for these agencies to come together and discuss issues and concerns with specific students within the Tomah School District.

I assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop off box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

I assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

I attended bi-weekly meetings with other Department Supervisors.

I conducted a Command Staff meeting.

I attended a meeting with personnel from Tomah Memorial Hospital, Monroe County Human Services and members of law enforcement to discuss medical and mental commitments.

I attended a meeting with members of the Monroe County Safe Community Coalition-Alcohol Work Group.

I attended a City Safety Meeting with other employees and supervisors within the City of Tomah.

I attended the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Training Conference. This conference was attended by approximately 375 Law Enforcement Executives from throughout Wisconsin. Lieutenant Waddell attended this conference with me.

I attended two meetings with the City of Tomah Emergency Management Committee. The meetings were established to review and finalize the City of Tomah's Emergency Operations Plan.

I attended the Combined Tactical Unit Commanders Meeting. Monroe County Sheriff Quirin, Sparta Chief of Police Chief Kass, and Sergeant Weaver also attended this meeting.

On February 20 the Tomah Police Department had Interdepartmental Training. As part of this training I took the opportunity to speak to all of the members of the department. During the meeting I discussed what members of the department could expect from me, what I expect from them, and different projects that we were going to be working on in 2014.

On January 15, 2014 I was appointed the Chief of Police in Tomah. On February 20, 2014 a formal Swearing-In Ceremony was held at the Police Department followed by a luncheon. The ceremony was attended by friends, family, fellow employee's and officials from the City of Tomah. Thank you to everyone that attended.

I attended a Child Death Review meeting. This meeting was attended by members of law enforcement, Monroe County Human Services, First Responders/Emergency Medical Technicians, District Attorney's Office and hospital staff.

On February 19 Lt. Waddell and I participated in Cops Gone Wild. Cops Gone Wild is a fundraiser for Special Olympics. This event was sponsored by the Onalaska Police Department and Buffalo Wild Wings. During the event Lt. Waddell and I were involved in a chicken wing eating contest. Lt. Waddell and I took 1st Place in our respective divisions. The event raised \$3,200.00 for Special Olympics athletes.

During the month of February I met with Licensed Agents/Owners of the businesses who failed our last alcohol compliance checks. During the meeting I stressed with them the importance checking ID's and turning away those that are not of age to purchase alcohol. Suggestions were provided to them on different things that they could be doing differently or policies that they could put in place to assist with this process.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of February 2014 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell

Current scheduling responsibilities have been assigned to Sergeant Holum, I provide oversight and guidance as required.

Met with a representative from Training and Standards regarding an audit of our personnel files. The audit was to insure the presence of required documents that show proof of citizenship, valid driver license, minimum college credits, proper background investigation, and medical pre-employment screening.

Organized a department training event at the Police Department.

Performed oversight on all building maintenance issues, to include work orders, accounts payable approvals, etc.

Attended a Command Staff Meeting.

I assisted with the copying of open records requests for DVD, VHS, and Compact Discs as needed.

I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts and was available for incident command/high risk calls

I monitored the Prescription Drug Drop Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department, which averages a full box every 1.5 weeks. The collection is for unused, unwanted or expired medications

I monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence as needed. The evidence responsibilities also required return of evidence and limited destruction of evidence as time permitted. Evidence was provided to officers for follow-up and/or turnover to other police agencies.

Fleet maintenance oversight continues with scheduled and unscheduled repairs.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

CALL OUTS:

Team Call Outs:

02/03/13 -- High Risk Arrest: CTH N, Rural Warrens. Monroe County Sheriff's Department requested CTU assistance with arresting a subject who was wanted by Wisconsin Department of Corrections for violating terms of his Probation & Parole Supervision as well as new charges. This subject had posted threatening messages on Facebook.com indicating that he would "go out with a bang" and may engage law enforcement in a gunfight. Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel attempted to communicate with the subject and with family members to convince the subject to turn himself in. However, the subject refused to meet deadlines for his surrender. Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel, working with other law enforcement agencies, developed information that the subject was at his parents residence and obtained a search warrant for the residence. CTU personnel requested assistance from the La Crosse County Sheriff's Department and two LaCrosse County Sheriffs Department Emergency Response Team deputies brought the LaCrosse County Sheriff's Office BEARCAT to the call out. CTU developed a plan to covertly surround the residence using sniper and K-9 assets and then use the BEARCAT as a show of authority in the driveway while directing the subject to exit the residence. The plan was approved and put into action. A subject leaving in a vehicle upon approach of the CTU was detained and nearly immediately the suspect's sister exited the

residence. After a short period of time the suspect exited the residence and was arrested without further incident.

TRAINING REVIEW:

Training was conducted at an unoccupied warehouse in Tomah and consisted of Vehicle Takedowns, Arrest Protocols and K-9 Assisted Vehicle Takedowns. The primary focus of the Vehicle Takedowns and the Arrest Protocol training was to develop an Standard Operating Procedure that we could then reduce to written form in the soon to be released SOP manual. Officers practiced refining our approach of a vehicle occupied in a hostage situation and reviewed the roles of each team member during the intervention. Officers also reviewed our arrest protocols; specifically the arrest of individuals armed with a handgun in a holster, waistband, pocket, etc. Lastly Officer Hintz had the opportunity to practice several insertions of K-9 Jager into a vehicle through an open window.

Spoke with parent having difficulty getting their child to come to school. Student eventually decided to come.

INVESTIGATIONS

[14-0151] Possession of Methamphetamine

A Tomah officer was stopped on the 1400 block of Butts Avenue when a male subject waved for him to stop. The officer met the male subject and attempted to assist in getting a cab but learned the male subject had no money. The officer was familiar with the male subject from prior police contacts and requested a wants/warrants check. The officer learned the male subject was on bond out of Monroe County and hadn't updated the address on the bond, which is a violation and a subsequent crime. The officer contacted the male subject and took him into custody. Incident to the lawful arrest a search was conducted of the male subject. The officer located methamphetamine on the male subject. The male subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail on numerous criminal charges.

[14-0156] Robbery, Battery, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, False Imprisonment, Taking Hostages

Tomah officers responded to the 1300 block of Superior Avenue after receiving information of a person being held hostage. Officers arrived, set up a perimeter and began to systematically control the scene. Officers began checking apartments and located the victim and a suspect. The suspect was taken into custody and was armed with a replica pistol in his waistband. Officers located another suspect and both were taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[14-0228] Disorderly Conduct – Alcohol Related

Tomah Officers responded to an address on the 1900 block of Superior Avenue for a report of a male subject trying to get into a house. Officers arrived and took a male subject into custody. The male subject had attempted to enter the front and side doors and was located at the back door. Officers learned the male subject was highly intoxicated and believed he was in New Lisbon. The male subject was given a ride home and issued a citation.

[14-0241] Bail Jumping (Felony), Possession of a Prescription Drug Without a Prescription, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Tomah officers responded to 1123 Superior Avenue for an unresponsive male subject. Officers located a subject who was unresponsive and began performing rescue breathing. Officers observed a fresh injection site in the male subject's arm. Officers seized items commonly associated with injecting illegal drugs. The male subject was transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital and was treated for opiate/opioid overdose. The male subject was ultimately medically cleared and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[14-0242] Marijuana Deliver/Manufacture/Distribute

Tomah officers were dispatched the 300 block of Green Acres Avenue for a male subject that was sleeping in a vehicle. Officers arrived and met a male subject who had remnants of marijuana on his person. The male subject provided officers with 36 grams of Marijuana. This case will be referred to the Monroe County District Attorney.
