

POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES:

I met with Attorney Penny Berry to prepare for the Wisconsin Employee Relation Commission Grievance Hearing. The Hearing was regarding the cleaning contract services at the Police Department and the AFSCME's objection to the contract services.

I met with a representative from the Ho-Chunk Housing Administration for the purpose obtaining contact information regarding a neighborhood problem.

I attended the Common Council meeting.

I attended the weekly Department Head staff meetings.

I attended the Committee As A Whole meeting.

I attended an electric motorcycle demonstration at the La Crosse Police Department.

I attended a Comprehensive Planning meeting at the Holiday Inn.

I conducted a Command staff meeting.

On Friday and Saturday, June 25 and 26, I spent time at the Tractor Pull.

I attended the Tractor Pull press briefing.

We conducted a tour of the police department for the Platteville Police Department Project Manager.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

Participated in a Disaster Drill Table Top at Tomah Memorial Hospital. This included representatives from Tomah Area Ambulance Service, Tomah Fire Department, Tomah Veterans Medical Center, Tomah Memorial Hospital, Ft. McCoy, and Tomah School District along with the Observer/Controllers.

Made preparations for July 4th parade (detour permit, request traffic assist from Wisconsin State Patrol, Public Works, and the Monroe County Sheriff's Reserves).

Passed out disaster drill flyers in the neighborhood being used for the Disaster Preparedness Exercise. The purpose of the flyers was to give advance notice to the residents that live in the area of the drill.

Planned, prepped and conducted a second round of officer candidate interviews.

Participated in the June 17 disaster drill. The focus of the exercise was working with an accident between a utility truck and a school bus with numerous occupants.

Facilitated the scheduling of personnel and coordinated the Department responsibilities for the Grand National Tractor Pull.

Attended and participated in a Command Staff Meeting.

PERSONNEL

Officer Keller was approved for Family Medical Leave.

Sergeant Chris Weaver was approved for Family Medical Leave.

TRAINING

Administrative Assistant Culpitt attended the Law Enforcement Administrative Professionals Conference.

Combined Tactical Unit – Firearm drills training was conducted by Sergeant Pedersen and Officer Hintz. Deputy Brose and Deputy Spencer zeroed their newly issued rifles and shot the Tomah Police Department qualification course. Training provided by Sergeant Pedersen and Officer Hintz included target discrimination drills, pivot turns, shooting on the move, and partner shooting.

Combined Tactical Unit – Training was held at the Miller Elementary School from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The training consisted of Defense and Arrest Tactics for the tactical officer and then several entry team scenarios with officers playing the part of suspects. Defense and Arrest Tactics were practiced using ASP striking pads with and without gear. The team was divided into two small entry groups for the purpose of practicing the

scenarios. Suspects presented striking pads during entry to facilitate practicing the tactics in simulation exercises.

School is out for the summer. School Resource Officer Marshall is assisting with patrol and community service duties.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

I conducted a tour of the police department for Retired Department of Natural Resources Warden Jim Kincannon.

I spoke on the Morning Mix 96 radio show. I spoke about the upcoming High School graduation.

I attended the weekly Tomah Rotary Club meetings.

I participate in the Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics.

I appeared on the Hagen Sports Network. I spoke about graduation, graffiti, rummage sale signs and summer activities near the Aquatic Center.

I participate in a photo opportunity at Tomah Memorial Hospital regarding a donation that the Foundation made to the K-9 replacement program.

I assisted with the Independence Day parade.

I volunteered at the Boys and Girls Club annual golf outing.

I attended Business After 5.

I participated in the Animal Shelter golf outing.

Officer Marshall participated in the Transportation Day in support of Family Resources. During that time I displayed the new K9 vehicle and was available to check car seats.

The National Night Out committee is busy planning this year's event. The event is scheduled to take place on August 4. The donation letters were sent out to area businesses in regards to donations for the Bike Rodeo that is coming up on August 4.

INVESTIGATIONS

[09-1180] Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of Prescription medication without a Prescription

Tomah Police observed a subject riding a bicycle and recognized this subject from prior police contacts. A records check revealed this subject had a warrant from Monroe County. The subject was stopped and during the contact the subject dropped a couple clear plastic baggy that had contained marijuana. The subject was taken into custody and searched incident to a lawful arrest. Police located marijuana, a pipe used to smoke marijuana, rolling papers and a single pill that was determined to be Methocarbomal. The subject was taken to jail.

[09-1235] Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Restricted Controlled Substance, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Tomah Police observed a vehicle that was speeding. The vehicle was stopped and marijuana was observed on the center console. The driver attempted to wipe the marijuana off the console and was taken into custody. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed 4 grams of marijuana and several items of drug paraphernalia. The subject was taken to jail.

[09-1239] Manufacture/Deliver drugs, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Drug Warehouse

Police were dispatched to the 400 block of E. Nott St. for a disturbance. Upon arrival police spoke with the involved parties and one of them admitted to possessing drug paraphernalia. The subject did not consent to a search of the residence so officers applied for a search warrant and one was granted. A search of the residence revealed numerous items of contraband to include recently prescribed empty pill bottles, a pill crusher, marijuana and several other drug related items.

[09-0947] Possession of Marijuana w/ Intent to Deliver, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Drug Warehouse

Police conducted a drug investigation on the 500 block of Mill St. A search warrant was executed and drugs and drug paraphernalia were located in the residence. Several subjects were taken into custody for drug related charges. Based on the deplorable living conditions the City of Tomah Building Inspector condemned the residence.

[09-1289] Resisting an Officer, Obstructing an Officer

Police responded to Dimensions Tavern for a disturbance. Upon arrival police were made aware of a male subject who had been groping several female bar patrons. This subject resisted arrest and was taken into custody. The male subject admitted to groping the buttocks of at least one female bar patron. The male subject was cited and released.

[09-1290] Disorderly Conduct

During the afore-mentioned disturbance (09-1289) a male subject interfered with the police. This male subject repeatedly cursed and created another disturbance. The male subject was warned several times to stay back and stop cursing. The male subject failed to comply and was taken into custody. The male subject stated he was in the military and training to be a member of the Army Special Forces and he was trained to curse. The subject was administered a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) and the result was .225 BAC. The subject was released to his father.

[09-1329] Strangulation/Suffocation, Disorderly Conduct, Battery

Police observed a fight in front of The Crow Bar that involved several subjects. Upon arrival there was a male subject who was unconscious lying on the sidewalk and another male subject lying on the sidewalk in the fetal position who was being punched repeatedly. Police were able to stop the subject from punching the other and as he was taken into custody another male subject jumped on top of this person and began punching him repeatedly. This male subject resisted police and was taken into custody with the use of a TASER. The scene was returned to order and several subjects were issued citations and/or taken to jail.

[09-1348] Knowingly Flee an Officer, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Probation and Parole Hold

Tomah Police observed a vehicle on N. Glendale Ave. that was speeding. A traffic stop was conducted but the vehicle fled onto Curry St. The vehicle was observed stopped on Curry St. with two subjects running from it. The vehicle continued on without stopping and police personnel were able to take the two subjects that ran from the vehicle into custody. The operator of the vehicle was located a short distance away and was taken into custody.
