## **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES**

I attended the Long Range Planning Committee meeting for the purpose of discussing the available liquor license.

Lieutenant Ron Waddell, Officer Aaron Hintz and I met with Chief O'Bong from the Veteran's Administration Police Department regarding an agency assist.

The Department hosted a meeting of the Coulee Region Law Enforcement Executive Group.

I attended a meeting of the City of Tomah Police and Fire Commission.

I attended the Common Council meetings.

I conducted an Administrative Staff meeting.

I conducted a Command Staff meeting.

I met with representatives from the Salvation Army.

Sergeant Eric Pedersen and I met with Building Inspector Shane Rolff regarding zoning violations.

## **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of January, 2011 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

Conducted Shift Supervisor duties on many of my scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence assuring proper packaging and identification was affixed.

Managed the filling of open records for video evidence to the public.

Filled video evidence requests from the District Attorney and City Attorney that were to be used in the prosecution of municipal or circuit court cases.

Managed all schedule-related issues for all sworn department members (comp, vacation, training, special assignment).

Attended Administrative Staff Meeting with Chief Revels, Lieutenant Nicholson, and Administrative Assistant Rhonda Culpitt.

Attended a meeting with Tomah High School representatives that included discussions about the School Resource Officer, upcoming events, and school safety.

Facilitate MEG supervisor duties (overseeing investigations, request reimbursement, submit monthly stats).

Attended a Command Staff meeting.

Completed evaluation process with all Sergeants and other assigned subordinates.

Participated in personnel evaluation meetings.

### **SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of January, 2011 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

I completed Evidence Custodian Duties related to the recovery, retention, and disposal of evidence. For the month of January, sixty-one pieces of evidence were processed into the evidence room.

I attended intra-departmental meetings to include an Administrative Staff Meeting and a Command Staff Meeting.

I attended a meeting held in Sparta for the Monroe County Alcohol and Drug Abuse School-Community Alliance Coalition.

During the month of January, I worked on two Personnel Complaints.

During the month of January, I prepared for and scheduled several different training sessions for officers within the Tomah Police Department. Those included department training sessions as well as classes and conferences that officers may be attending. Two training sessions are being held at the Tomah Police Department and have been opened up to local Public Safety agencies to include Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services.

I assisted in filling video evidence requests from the District Attorney and the City Attorney that were to be used in the prosecution of municipal or circuit court cases.

During January, Lieutenant Waddell and I prepared and administered the annual evaluations to the Sergeants.

I attended a Wellness Committee meeting. The Wellness Committee is working on several projects at this time to include an Employee Assistance Program, an Entry Level Fitness Test, a fitness program for tenured officers, and a drug testing program for police officers.

### **SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER ACTIVITIES**

**[11-0014] Possession of Child Pornography/Manufacture Child Pornography and Distribute Child Pornography**

Based on information received from a student it was discovered a male student had sent a female student photographs of his genitals. Upon further investigation it was learned the female student had also sent photographs of herself to the male subject. This case is still under investigation but charges will be referred to MCHS.

**[11-0059] Disorderly Conduct and Battery to School Official**

Charges of disorderly conduct and battery to school official referred to MCHS for a 9 year old who caused a disturbance at RKLC. He also spit and kicked a teacher which resulted in the teacher receiving medical treatment.

**[11-0075] Warrant Arrest**

While leaving the high school for the middle school I observed a parent waiting in a vehicle outside of the high school. The parent had a valid City of Tomah warrant and was taken into custody and transported to the jail.

**[11-0115 and 11-0157] Theft**

Same student cited for theft two times after stealing bottles of water from the school cafeteria.

**[11-0116 and 11-0166] Disorderly Conduct**

These cases involve physical altercations that involved students. 3 students cited for municipal disorderly conduct.

**[11-0076] Locker Search**

During a locker search at TMS medications were discovered in a locker. It was determined that the student held a valid prescription for the medications. No law enforcement charges, as it was only a school discipline issue.

During the month I taught G.R.E.A.T. lessons number five and six at Tomah Middle School. There are a total of 10 Sixth grade classes. Officer Marshall contacted St. Mary's regarding G.R.E.A.T.

On February 18<sup>th</sup>, Officer Marshall presented car seat information to 3 and 4 year old children and their parents at the Tomah Head Start Program.

Eight citations were issued for habitual truancy.

### TRAINING

Lieutenant Waddell, Lieutenant Nicholson and I attended the Wisconsin Chief's of Police Conference.

### CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Department sponsored a luncheon in honor of the School Crossing Guards. The luncheon was well attended. The Crossing Guard received a Certificate of Appreciation.

### INVESTIGATIONS

#### **[11-0009] Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers responded to Kelsey's Bar for a report of a fight in progress. Upon arrival Officers observed a male subject without a shirt on and another that had scraped knuckles. The Officers initially had difficulty getting the male subject with no shirt on to cooperate because this subject was highly intoxicated and clearly agitated. Officers were able to control the subject after they explained that they were going to use an Electronic Control Device to assist in controlling him. Both subjects were highly intoxicated and denied any involvement in an altercation. Witnesses were able to provide detailed information that contradicted what the two male subjects were claiming. Both male subjects were taken to the Monroe County Jail.

#### **[11-0011] Disorderly Conduct**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the Park Motel in regards to a complaint that an occupant there had threatened to shoot himself with a gun. Dispatch was able to contact the subject and he opened the door. Several times the subject came to the door and then refused to exit the room. The subject yelled at police that we were "pussies" for not coming into the room. A neighbor in an adjoining room came outside and was escorted from the area. Eventually, the subject came outside and was detained without further incident. An interview with the subject determined that his suicidal threats were not credible. The subject was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and transported to Monroe County Jail. A consent search of the subject's motel room was conducted and no firearm was located.

#### **[11-0022] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated/Operating After Revocation/Possession of Marijuana/Warrant**

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop after observing suspicious driving behavior and a couple equipment violations. The Officer spoke with the operator and could smell a strong odor of alcohol. The Officer attempted to conduct Standardized Field Sobriety Tests but the operator refused to do them. The operator was taken into custody for two warrants, Operating After Revocation and Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-3<sup>rd</sup> offense. The Officer conducted a search incident to a lawful arrest and located marijuana in the purse of the operator. The operator was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[11-0034] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-4<sup>th</sup> (Felony)/Operating After Suspension/Bail Jumping/Unsafe Lane Deviation**

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop for suspicion of operator impairment. The operator of the vehicle had been consuming alcohol and Standardized Field Sobriety Tests were conducted. The operator was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-4<sup>th</sup> offense (Felony). The vehicle operator also did not have a valid driver's license and was on bond with no-drink restrictions. The operator's Preliminary Breath Test indicated a result of .168 BAC. The blood evidence that was seized from the operator and sent to the Wisconsin State Laboratory of Hygiene-Toxicology Section was returned with a Blood Alcohol Concentration of .204.

**[11-0040] Child Enticement**

The Tomah Police Department received information that a 22-year-old male subject was sending sexually explicit text messages to a 15-year-old female. The investigations revealed that a male subject from Grand Marsh, WI had been sending text messages and ultimately came to the City of Tomah to meet the 15-year-old female. The suspect was located by Tomah Officers at a location on the north end of the City of Tomah. The suspect was taken into custody. The suspect spoke with Officers and was subsequently transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[11-0118] Agency Assist/Recovered Stolen Property**

Tomah Officers assisted the Monroe County Sheriff's Department with the service of a search warrant at an address on the 400 block of N. Glendale Ave. Once the search warrant was served the Monroe County Sheriff's Deputies located several electronic items that had been reported stolen by the Tomah Police Department. The Tomah Police Department, with the assistance of the Monroe County Sheriff's Department, were able to locate stolen items that were related to four different cases in the City of Tomah. The suspects were identified and will face charges of Possession of Stolen Property, Theft and Burglary.

**[11-0093] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-7<sup>th</sup> (Felony)/Operating After Revocation/Probation Hold**

Tomah Officers received information that a male subject had just left his residence and was intoxicated. Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The operator appeared intoxicated and an Officer administered

Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The operator was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-7<sup>th</sup> offense. The operator's Preliminary Breath Test was .202 BAC.
