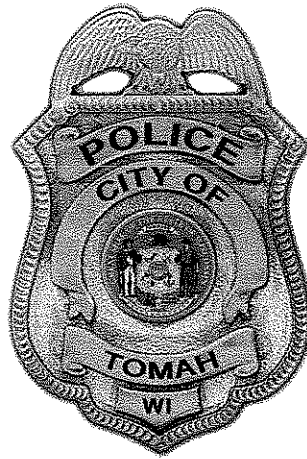

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

I attended the Department Head staff meetings with the Mayor and City Administrator.

I conducted an Administrative Staff meeting and a Command Staff meeting.

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition.

Sheriff Quirin, Chief Kass and I conducted a meeting with other supervisory staff for the purpose of discussing the Combined Tactical Unit.

Administrative Assistant Culpitt, Investigator Walensky and I met with Natalie Carlisle the Drug Free Community Grant Coordinator.

I attended the Emergency Operations training at the Tomah Police Department organized by Fire Chief Decorah.

I attended the Emergency Services Association meeting held at the North Side Fire Station.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of January, 2012 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Attended Municipal Court as the Court Officer.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Attended an Administrative Staff meeting.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 312 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room in January.

Managed and processed Open Records Requests for audio and video related evidence.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Attended meetings with the Monroe County Sheriff's Department and the Sparta Police Department to discuss joint operations.

Attended the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Mid-Winter Training Seminar. Topics of training included Investigating Hate Crimes, City of Fond du Lac Shooting Debrief, Social Medias Impact on Law Enforcement, Support provided by Wisconsin Division of Criminal Investigations, and Legal Update.

Attended the West Central Metropolitan Enforcement Groups monthly meeting.

Attended Emergency Operations Center Course training. The training utilized real world scenario's to address the operations, planning, logistics and financing if and when an Emergency Operations Center is utilized during a disaster.

Attended Emergency Operations training at the Tomah Police Department organized by Fire Chief Decorah.

Performed Time Agency Coordinator responsibilities.

Facilitated the patrol and supervisor training schedules. Scheduled a Department Legal Update with Assistant Attorney General Dave Perlman in March.

Attended and participated in Command Staff Meeting with Department Administration and Sergeant Staff.

Attended and participated in a Multi-Disciplinary Team Meeting that included members of Monroe County Human Services, Monroe County Sheriff Department, Sparta Police Department, Monroe County Corporation Council. This team meets quarterly to discuss current laws, policies, and protocols that govern each agency during investigations that involve children that are at risk or danger of abuse.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Combined Tactical Unit Monthly Report – January 2012

Call Out: January 22 – Super 8 Motel

Combined Tactical Unit personnel responded to a call of a barricaded subject who was intoxicated and armed with a firearm at the Super 8 Motel. Additional information was that the subject was seen in the hallway waving the gun around and threatening to kill himself. Responding police officers confronted the subject and he initially complied with police orders, but then fled into his room. Upon arrival Combined Tactical Unit personnel completed a time consuming, but very safe and very orderly evacuation of 15 other rooms in the wing where the subject was located. After all other persons were evacuated from the area a Crisis Negotiator attempted to contact the subject, but the subject was uncooperative with attempts to communicate. Combined Tactical Unit personnel then delivered a Flash bang device outside of the subject's room window in an attempt to elicit some response from the subject but he continued to be uncooperative. Eventually, Combined Tactical Unit personnel breached the window of the room and threw an Oleoresin Capsicum Vapor grenade into the room. The Oleoresin Capsicum Vapor grenade was very effective and within seconds the subject exited the room and was taken into custody without further incident. Tomah Fire Department personnel who were on-scene immediately began venting the Oleoresin Capsicum from the hotel and within an hour the guests were able to return to their rooms.

Training:

January 11 – Training at Tomah Police Department.

Training for the month of January consisted of a team meeting with individual reports on the new Standard Operating Procedures and Physical Fitness and Firearms standards. Sgt. Weaver was named by the Combined Tactical Unit governing body (Sheriff Quirin, Tomah Police Chief Revels and Sparta Police Chief Kass) as Commander of the Combined Tactical Unit.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

January 2nd

Completed six referrals to Municipal Court for Habitual Truancy.

Spoke with student in regards to Quick 50; however, they did not have specific information. No follow up required.

Spoke with a student and another parent in regards to a stolen vehicle. No report taken as a result of the victim's parent did not want police involved.

Spoke with staff member in regards to a home burglary at their residence.

January 3rd

Spoke with Middle School staff in regards to filing truancy on a student. This student also walked away from school on December 22.

Finished Habitual Truancy cases from the previous day.

Spoke with Monroe County Human Services in regards to concerns about students.

Spoke with the father of a student in regards to their child having sexual relations with his/her boyfriend/girlfriend.

Spoke with two students in regards to a receiving nude photos of another student. Followed up with a conversation with a parent of the student sending nude photos. Also spoke with the student who denied sending the pictures.

Had a conversation about the concerns of a student deemed to be homeless.

January 4th

Met with a student at the Tomah Middle School in regards to the use of profanity. Student was cited for Disorderly Conduct.

Met with student at the Tomah Middle School in regards to the use of profanity. Student was warned; however after speaking with the student they created a disturbance and were later removed from the school. Student was evaluated for possible Chapter 51 and then released to parents. Student referred to Monroe County Human Services for Disorderly Conduct.

January 5th

Spoke with a homeless student for the purpose of determining where they are living. Parent directed student to stay with a friend. It was decided that the student would continue to stay with relatives in Sparta.

January 6th

Gathered information from Curt Reavis related to damages at Miller Elementary School.

Spoke with a student in regards to questions they had related to truancy.

Habitual Truancy citations served to some students at the Robert Kupper Learning Center.

Spoke with a class in regards to current news events.

January 9th

Instructed G.R.E.A.T. at the Tomah Middle School.

January 10th

Instructed G.R.E.A.T. at the Tomah Middle School.

January 11th

Spoke with a Middle School student in regards to a party they had at their house the previous weekend and the allegations that they were giving pills to other students. I also spoke with the student's parent about the allegations.

January 12th

Spoke with a student in regards to harassment issues involving another student. Spoke with the other half of the harassment complaint who wanted to complain about the other student. I had a stern conversation with this student in regards to lying to get other people in trouble. Participated in a follow up conversation with the parent of the student regarding issues within the home.

January 13th

Spoke with a parent in regards to concerns related to whether or not their child would be charged in the recent tattoos and body piercings investigation.

Spoke with a parent in regards to harassment issues with their child from the previous day.

Spoke with a student who did not appear for truancy court this week. Put student in contact with the Court Clerk who advised of the fine.

Spoke with a student in regards to restitution that they had requested. Student was put in contact with the Court Clerk who informed the student that she had received the signed paperwork related to the restitution.

Spoke with a parent regarding injuries that their child received in one of their classes and the circumstances surrounding the incident.

January 17th

Completed Habitual Truancy paperwork.

Spoke with a parent in regarding a community relations request for the Boy Scouts.

January 18th

Spoke with a student regarding theft of a calculator from a classroom. Student was issued a Municipal citation for Theft.

Assisted with supervision of the Lunchroom.

Spoke with a parent regarding their child harassing other students.

Completed a Trespassing incident report.

Spoke with a student in related to their walking out of the Alternative Learning and Attendance Center.

January 19th

Arrested a student for two counts of Disorderly Conduct, Resisting an Officer and Battery. Subject created a disturbance at the High School refusing the listen to the staff members along with placing a choke hold on another student and dragging the student.

Responded to the Robert Kupper Learning Center and completed a Commitment Evaluation.

Spoke with a student in regards to a traffic complaint.

Assisted other officers with a problem with a student at the Miller Elementary School.

January 20th

Completed the School Resource Officer annual report.

Spoke with a representative of Walmart regarding a shoplifting complaint. Suspect was found to be in the store at the time of the follow up.

Assisted with a K-9 search at Tomah Middle School.

January 24th and January 25th

Instructed G.R.E.A.T. classes at Tomah Middle School.

January 26th and January 27th

Attended the School Resource Officer Training Conference Madison.

January 30th

Instructed G.R.E.A.T. classes at Tomah Middle School.

Spoke with a parent in regards to an incident in which their child was injured by another student. After speaking with students it was learned some student were throwing snowballs which angered the injured student. The injured student hit the other student who in turn hit the injured student back, which left the bruise. Students counseled for their behavior.

January 31st

Instructed G. R. E. A. T. classes at Tomah Middle School.

TRAINING

Officer Walters attended Field Training Officer course at Chippewa Valley Technical College. He successfully completed the training and is now qualified to mentor new officers.

Chief Revels, Lt. Nicholson, and Lt. Waddell attended the Mid-Winter Chiefs Conference in Wisconsin Dells. This training consisted of legal updates in state law, updates with fair labor standards act applications, social media influences, hate crimes, officer involved shooting debriefs, and resources made available to local law enforcement from the Department of Criminal Investigations.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Sergeant Eric Pedersen provided firearms familiarization training to several staff members at Tomah Memorial Hospital.

The Department is currently working with the Monroe County Safety Coalition and the Drug Free Community Grant Coordinator on the upcoming Community Drug Awareness Forum. The Forum is scheduled for February 23 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. The Forum will be held at the Tomah Senior Citizen Center.

I spoke on the topic of Bullying to the Freshman class at the request of Dr. Luebke.

INVESTIGATIONS

[12-0144] **Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol related Physical, Resisting an Officer**
Tomah Officers were on the 1100 block of Superior Avenue when they observed a subject urinating in the street. The subject was contacted and Officers were able to determine he was intoxicated. The subject was talking with another bar patron and decided to try and punch this other person in the face. The subject was decentralized and began physically resisting the Officers attempts at securing his arms behind his back. An Electronic Control Device was used and aided the Officers in controlling the physically resistive subject. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[12-0161] **Intoxicated use of a weapon, Disorderly Conduct, Possession of Marijuana, Resisting an Officer, Failure to Comply with Officer**
Tomah Officers responded to the Super 8 Hotel for a report of a suicidal subject who was armed with a pistol. Officers observed the subject in a hallway and began to give verbal orders. The subject initially complied but soon entered his room and closed the door. The Monroe County Combined Tactical Unit was activated and arrived on scene. Careful and deliberate actions were taken to remove citizens from the surrounding hotel rooms and move them to a safe location. Once the citizens were all removed Officers attempted to contact the subject via the phone in the room; the subject never responded. A chemical agent (OC vapor) was introduced to the subject's room through an exterior window. Shortly after the chemical agent was deployed the subject exited his room. The subject was taken into custody without further incident.

[12-0168] **Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Psilocybin Manufacturing**
Tomah Officers responded to an address on the 100 block of East Veterans Street for a disturbance. Officer arrived and had contact with a male and a female subject who could be heard arguing from outside the residence. During the investigation Officers located a

psilocybin grow inside the residence. Officers also located marijuana and a marijuana smoking device, a couple scales, and an assortment of other items that were used to aid the grow of the Psilocybin mushrooms. A male subject was taken into custody for the aforementioned charges.

[12-0202] Possession of a Schedule II narcotic Drug, Obstructing an Officer, Bail Jumping

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on Kozarek Street for a male subject who was having difficulty with his "Pain patch." Officers arrived and determined that the male subject had used the contents of a Fentanyl patch to inject into his arm. The subject declined assistance from the ambulance service. The subject admitted to getting the controlled substance from another subject in the City of Tomah. The male subject was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail. The male subject has an open criminal case through Monroe County for drug related charges.
