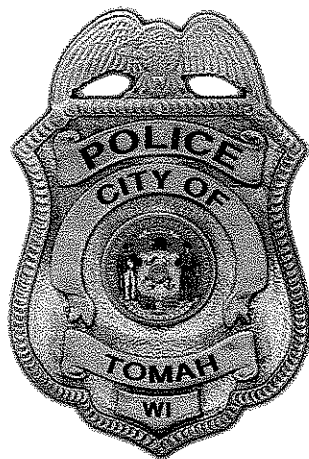

POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition.

I attended a meeting organized by representatives from the Wisconsin Emergency Police Services and Wisconsin Emergency Management. The presenters and participants reviewed available resources and the procedures for acquiring the resources when the need arises. Generally speaking, the personnel resources used through the Wisconsin Emergency Police Services are at a cost to the requesting agency under the Wisconsin Mutual Aid legislation. Most of the resources available through the Wisconsin Emergency Management system are cost free.

I meet with a representative from Viterbo College to discuss educational needs for law enforcement in Western Wisconsin. In the near future they will be administering a survey of departmental personnel related to their education needs.

I conducted two Administrative Staff meetings.

Officer Helgerson's probationary period was over on July 18th. She was granted tenure with the Department.

I attended a meeting in La Crosse with representatives of Human Services and area Law Enforcement at the CARE Center. The CARE Center is a Mental Health Crisis Stabilization Hospital. The CARE Center provides intermediate crisis intervention and social detoxification to assist persons who are in crisis but not under Chapter 51 detentions. Monroe County Human Service personnel are exploring the possibility of using the services of the Center.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of July, 2011 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests' made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Attended Administrative Staff Meetings held at the Tomah Police Department.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room.

Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Assisted in the Medication Take Back Program. This process entails the removal and destruction of medications that are voluntarily turned into the Tomah Police Department.

Facilitated the process of hiring a replacement officer for Officer Schneider. Participated in the police department staff interviews of fifteen candidates. Six candidates were approved to move forward to an interview with the Police and Fire Commission.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of July, 2011 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

Conducted Shift Supervisor duties on many of my scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence assuring proper packaging and identification was affixed.

Attended Administrative Staff Meetings with Chief Revels, Lieutenant Nicholson, and Administrative Assistant Culpitt, where department goals/responsibilities were discussed.

Facilitated all training related events for department staff, to include a department wide training July 14, entitled "In Harm's Way", which identified methods to prevent suicide within the law enforcement profession.

Currently reviewing and making necessary changes to several departmental policies and procedures.

Met with Monroe County Investigative Sergeant Ron Rader to discuss the current status of an OWI Court that will be implemented in the near future.

Participated in police officer candidate interviews.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Call Outs: No callouts in the month of July.

Training:

Training was held at the Volk Field and Lagrange School in Tomah. Training at Volk Field consisted of rural area searches with K-9s. We were only able to conduct one search with each K-9 before we were forced to leave due to the high concentration of mosquitoes at the training site. Training at Lagrange School consisted of SWAT & K-9 integrated building searches. Officer Welker and K-9 Nitro from Sparta Police Department attended and worked with the tactical team as well as Officer Hintz and K-9 Jager from Tomah Police Department. Officer Hintz and K-9 Jager are assigned to the tactical unit and the attendance of Officer Welker and K-9 Nitro gave us the opportunity to expose them to some of our tactics and the opportunity for us all to train together.

Jackson County Sheriff and Juneau County Sheriff K-9 Units, both bloodhounds, were scheduled to attend, but due to a meeting, Jackson County Sheriff Chief Deputy Moan was unable to attend. A decision was made to re-schedule the training with the bloodhounds. The Tactical Unit is planning to integrate the bloodhound, patrol dog and tactical team into a plan for safely searching for armed and dangerous suspects in rural areas.

TRAINING

Investigator Walensky attended a Department of Justice sponsored training in Appleton. The training topic was "Child Fatality Investigation".

Sergeant Weaver attended a Gel Ballistic training session in Madison.

Members of the Department participated in Firearms qualifications in the month of July.

Members of the Department attended a training program entitled, "In Harm's Way". The program objectives are listed below:

Course Objectives:

- Identify how warning signs of depression appear in those who work in law enforcement professions.
- Identify how suicidal tendencies and risky behavior manifest in law enforcement personnel.
- Develop strategies for intervention when an officer is at risk for suicide including decoding communication, accessing resources, making referrals, and follow-up care.

- Learn QPR (Question, Persuade, and Refer), a nationally recognized suicide prevention program.
- Integrate current information about suicide prevention and treatment of depression into departmental policies and procedures related to health and wellness.
- Raise awareness of the impact of suicide within the ranks of law enforcement.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Department made arrangements for the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's new mobile training facility (The REF) to be at the Monroe County Fair. The request was made in partnership with the Monroe County Safety Coalition. The REF is designed to reach out to motorcycle riders and to educate and encourage formal rider training. The REF comes to where the riders are and is designed to be non-intrusive, while still offering the most critical of survival tips. The REF encourages both riders and non-riders to learn more about sharing the road, crash avoidance, and environmental awareness. The REF is part of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's ZERO IN WISCONSIN program to reduce the number of annual deaths on Wisconsin roads.

I assisted the Area Community Theater as an Usher during one of the performances of "Our Town".

I meet with representatives from the Our Town Tomah group.

INVESTIGATIONS

[11-1169] OMVWI-1st, OAS-4th, Warrant

A Tomah Officer stopped a vehicle for expired registration. The vehicle operator exited the vehicle and immediately informed the Officer that he had two warrants for his arrest. The Officer smelled the odor of intoxicants on the subject's breath and administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The subject was arrested for OMVWI-1st offense. The operator was processed for OMVWI at the Tomah Police Department. The subject's Blood Alcohol Concentration was .18 BAC. The subject was transported to jail.

[11-1187] OMVWI-3rd, Open Intoxicant in Motor Vehicle, OMVWI-BAC

Tomah Officers received a traffic complaint and located the vehicle in question on N. Superior Ave. near Burger King. The vehicle was stopped and the operator parked the vehicle in the middle of West Saratoga Street. The Officer smelled the odor of intoxicants coming from the operator and administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The operator was arrested for OMVWI-3rd offense. The operator was taken to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a legal blood

draw. The blood evidence was sent to the Wisconsin State Laboratory of Hygiene-Toxicology Section. The blood evidence final result indicated the operator's Blood Alcohol Concentration was .423 BAC; over five times the legal limit.

[11-1228] Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of Schedule II Narcotic Drug

Tomah Officers received a request from the Sparta Police Department to be on the lookout for a vehicle that was involved in a theft in the City of Sparta. Tomah Officers located the vehicle in the City of Tomah. Officers spoke with a subject who was believed to be involved in the theft in Sparta. This subject gave Officers consent to search a purse and Officers located a kit of drug paraphernalia that's used to inject heroin. Officers also located a pill bottle on this subject that contained several different prescriptions that did not belong to this subject. The subject gave Officers consent to search the subject's residence. Officers located numerous additional items of drug paraphernalia (Burnt spoons, used needles etc.) and a ballistic vest, similar to what Police Officers wear; these items were seized as evidence. Tomah Officers assisted the Sparta Police Department by arresting two of their suspect's from the theft in Sparta. These two suspects were taken to jail.

[11-1252] Disorderly Conduct, Resisting an Officer, Throwing/Expelling Bodily Fluids

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on the 300 block of Kilbourn Ave. for a reported disturbance. An Officer arrived and began speaking to the victim. The suspect exited the residence and the Officer attempted to take the suspect into custody. The suspect initially refused and the Officer deployed his department issued Electronic Control Device and pointed it at the suspect. The suspect cooperated long enough for the Officer to secure the suspect with handcuffs. The suspect then began to fight with the Officer and spit in the Officer's face. The suspect was taken to the jail.

[11-1254] Violation of Absolute Sobriety, OAR-1st (OWI related), Underage Alcohol, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Glendale Ave. for a possible injured person. While on scene Officers observed a vehicle pull up in front of the residence. The vehicle operator was contacted and determined to be 17-years-old and highly intoxicated. The operator was arrested for Violation of Absolute Sobriety. The operator also didn't have a valid drivers' license and was in possession of marijuana and a device used to smoke marijuana. The operator submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .204 BAC. The operator was processed and taken to jail.

[11-1259] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol related/Physical

Tomah Officers were in the downtown area and notified of a fight in progress on the 100 block of East Monowau Street. Officers arrived and located three subjects, one of them had a ripped shirt and a broken ankle. Officers determined two males and a female were mutually involved in the physical altercation and all were intoxicated. All three received citations. The subject with the broken ankle refused an ambulance and was taken to the hospital in a cab.

[11-1260] Disorderly Conduct, Underage Alcohol, Obstructing an Officer, Possession of Marijuana (Felony), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Warrant

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the Hearty Platter restaurant for a disturbance. Additional information provided was that there were a couple patrons who were cursing and throwing food. Officers arrived and met with the suspects. Both of the suspects had been consuming alcohol and one of the suspects was not 21-years-old. The subject who wasn't of legal drinking age gave the Officers false information in an attempt to avoid being cited for Underage Alcohol Consumption. This subject was ultimately cited for Disorderly Conduct, Underage Alcohol and Obstructing an Officer. The other suspect was taken to jail for a Monroe County Warrant. When the subject was taken into custody and searched Officers found a marijuana smoking device that later tested positive for the presence of Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC). This subject already has at least one prior conviction for Possession of Marijuana and was booked into the jail for Possession of Marijuana-Felony, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and the warrant. This subject was also issued a municipal citation for Disorderly Conduct.

[11-1323] OMVWI-1st, Possession of Prescription Medication without a Prescription

Tomah Officers received a traffic complaint of a vehicle that was driving all over the road to include the grassy median on North Superior Avenue. The vehicle was located a short time later on N. Glendale Ave. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was arrested for OMVWI-1st offense. The subject was administered a Preliminary Breath Test on scene and the result was .373 BAC. The subject was processed, medically cleared due to the extreme level of alcohol and taken to jail.
