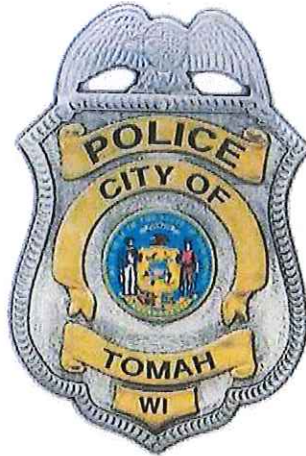

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of July, 2013 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

I assumed command of the department due to the retirement of Chief Wesley Revels.

I attended the monthly Committee of Whole meeting.

I attended the Multi-Jurisdictional Investigation Group meeting held in Sparta. Those in attendance included staff from the Sparta Police Department, Monroe County Sheriff's Department, Monroe County Human Services, Wisconsin Dept of Corrections, and the Monroe County Corporation Counsel.

I attended the Tomah Citizens Police Academy Alumni meeting.

I attended the Coulee Region Law Enforcement Executive Group (CRLEEG) meeting held with other Law Enforcement Supervisors. Topics discussed during the meeting included the Federal Driver Protection Act and an update related to Methamphetamine production.

I attended the 911 Monroe County Advisory meeting. Those in attendance included Law Enforcement, EMS, and Fire Departments from throughout Monroe County.

I attended the Tomah Veterans Affairs Medical Center Mental Health and Homeless Summit. The summit brought community stakeholders together with a goal of enhancing access to mental health services and addressing the mental healthcare and homeless needs of Veterans residing in the area.

I attended the Monroe County CouleeCap meeting.

I completed requests made by the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. I managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

I assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Combined Tactical Unit Report – JULY 2013

TRAINING REVIEW:

Joint training was conducted in La Crosse with La Crosse Police Department Emergency Response Team and La Crosse County Sheriff Department Emergency Response Team. La Crosse Police ERT coordinated the training and the morning session was held at five vacant houses that were to be torn down the following day. The majority of the morning was spent working individually, rotating through three

houses separately. Two live-time multi-breach point entries were conducting on the last two houses, which consisted of three apartments in each structure. La Crosse County Sheriff Department ERT conducted explosive breaches for our team on the last two houses – one of the explosive breaches was conducted on two breach points simultaneously, which required coordination between the three teams involved. The afternoon session of training was conducted at Central High School in La Crosse with Monroe County CTU and La Crosse Police ERT and involved responding to an active shooter situation in a large building and integrating two teams working in the same structure separately.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT CALL OUTS:

07/25/13: Rural Warrens. Monroe County Sheriff's Department requested Combined Tactical Unit (CTU) call out to a report of a suicidal subject who had fired shots and had a small child in the residence with him. Due to the presence of the small child CTU responded to assist. Upon arrival Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel and Wisconsin State Patrol personnel were in the area, but not close enough to see the residence. CTU personnel approached the residence on foot and established an inner perimeter position and sniper position. Once CTU personnel were in position Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel contacted the subject via telephone and the subject agreed to exit the residence where he was taken into custody without incident. CTU personnel turned the subject over to Monroe County Sheriff's Department personnel.

TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT TACTICAL CALL OUTS:

Training:

Training was held on May 21st in Tomah. Training consisted of a team meeting and discussion of some recent tactical events. All team members present past their agency's physical agility test. After break we responded to assist TPD with a reported suicidal armed subject. Training concluded at the TPD range with firearms training conducted by Sgt. Pedersen.

INVESTIGATIONS

13-1097] Recklessly Endangering Safety, Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on Packard St. for a report of a disturbance between a husband and wife. Additionally, it was reported that the husband was armed with a knife and was trying

to cut his wife. Officers arrived and took the husband into custody. The incident was investigated and the husband was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-1137] Possession of a Synthetic Cannabinoid, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Bail Jumping-felony

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on the 1000 block of Grandview Ave. Officers arrived and met with a female victim. The victim indicated her boyfriend had fled prior to Police arrival. Officers located the suspect as he was passed out inside a shed. The suspect had synthetic cannabinoid and a pipe next to him while he was seated in the shed. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-1138] Stalking

Tomah Officers met with a female subject at the Police Department. The female subject provided several hand written notes that were left on her car by someone. The notes were extremely crude and contained sexually suggestive comments. The female subject also provided a business card from a person who left it on her vehicle the day she was reporting it. Contact was made with the person whose name was on the business card. This person ultimately admitted to writing and leaving the notes on her vehicle. The male suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail and charged with Stalking.

[13-1198] Obstructing an Officer, Reckless Driving, Underage Consumption of Alcohol, Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the area of E. Juneau St and Glendale Ave. for a reported reckless driver. A description of the vehicle was provided and the vehicle was located at an address on the 300 block of E. Council St. The vehicle was occupied by three younger males who exited the vehicle upon seeing a Police Officer. The operator was ordered to stop and refused. The operator looked back at the Officer twice and still refused to stop. The operator was taken into custody and determined to be underage. The operator was highly uncooperative and was taken to the Police Department for processing. The operator's Blood Alcohol Concentration was .13. The operator was eventually released to his grandmother.

[13-1215] Bail Jumping-Felony, Resisting an Officer, Probation Hold, Theft, Possession of Stolen Property

Tomah Officers received information that a resident of Tomah was following a person who was suspected of stealing items from a vehicle. Officers located the suspect as he sat in a backyard. The suspect immediately ran from the Police. The suspect was controlled with the use of an Electronic Control Device and taken into custody. The suspect was in possession of numerous stolen items. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail. The suspect had been released from prison less than two weeks prior to this incident.
