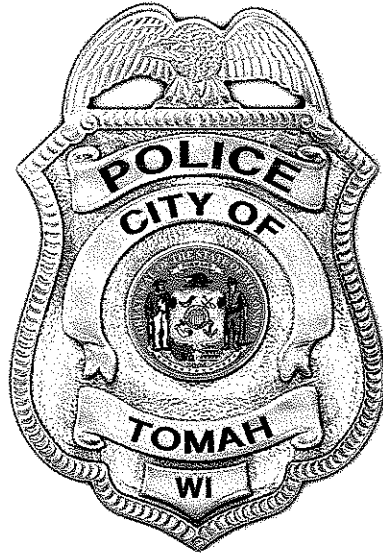


# **TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**June 2010 Report**

**POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS**

### **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES:**

Lieutenant Waddell and I met with representatives of the Ag. Society and discussed the policing arrangements for the Tractor Pull.

Selected members of the Department conducted an interview for the purpose of filling a vacant position at the Department.

I attended a meeting with the Law Enforcement Administrators of Monroe County.

Representatives from the Department and the District Attorney's Office met with the family of Vance Evans. Mr. Evans was the victim in an ongoing death investigation.

I conducted two personnel interviews.

### **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

Conducted Shift Supervisor duties on many of my scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming evidence.

Attended meeting with President of the Monroe County Ag Society, Dave Schreier.

Finalized Fourth of July parade route assignments.

Completed Evidence Custodian Duties related to the recovery, retention, and disposal of evidence.

Prepared for and reviewed documents related to a new officer.

Completed duties related to the Medicine Drop Off Program.

Prepared paperwork and registered department members for training.

Supervised department activities at the Monroe County Tractor pull.

Attended training in reference to acquiring Military Excess Equipment (1033 Program).

## **TRAINING**

I attended the third week of a three week program titled, "Leadership in Police Organizations".

Department members took part in firearms qualifications.

The Combined Tactical Unit trained at the Monroe County Sheriff's Department range. The training consisted of zeroing weapons, shooting drills with both pistol and rifle along with sniper initiated live fire entry training.

## **CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

I appeared on WBOG's Morning Mix radio program.

Sgt. Preuss and I participated in a fundraising/awareness event for domestic violence. The event, "Walk a Mile In her Shoes" was held at Riverside Park in La Crosse.

I participated in the Animal Shelter and Boys and Girls Club golf outings.

Sgt. Pedersen, Officer Schneider, Officer Walters and I attended an Ice Cream Social for the Heeler/Grandview Neighborhood Watch.

The Department is again working in partnership with Tomah Memorial Hospital to organize National Night Out. This year's event is schedule to take place on August 3<sup>rd</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Winnebago Park.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **[10-1181] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related**

Tomah Officers were in front of Brahma's Bar dealing with a disturbance. A female subject who was not involved began yelling, cursing and screaming that she was going to beat the person up who was standing next to her. This female subject was detained by the Police and escorted away. This female subject was intoxicated and continued to yell profanities and indicated she wanted to fight another female that was standing outside the bar. This female subject was cited and released.

### **[10-1191] OMVWI-1<sup>st</sup>/Prohibited Alcohol Concentration**

Tomah Police received a traffic complaint indicating that an intoxicated male subject had just left the Hearty Platter and was traveling south on Superior Avenue in a red truck. Officers located the vehicle in question at the intersection of North Superior Avenue and Veterans Street. An Officer positioned his squad car behind the vehicle and observed the subject crash into the vehicle in front of him. Tomah Officers conducted an investigation to determine if this male subject was impaired. The male subject was determined to be impaired and was subsequently taken into custody. The male subject had mixed alcohol with prescription medication.

### **[10-1229] Public Nuisance (Urinating in Public)**

Tomah Police received information that a male subject was at the Oak Grove Cemetery urinating on a statue of the Virgin Mary. Additional information was provided by the complainant to include a clothing description and that the subject was holding a can of beer. An intoxicated subject was located matching the description provided by the complainant. This subject admitted to urinating and also to consuming alcohol. The subject was cited and released. The subject submitted to a PBT (Preliminary Breath Test) and the result was .134 BAC.

### **[10-1271] Licensed Bartender Not on Premises/Acting as bartender without License**

Tomah Officers conducted a compliance check at The Crow Bar. Officers entered and observed 25-35 patrons inside the bar and some were consuming alcoholic beverages. Officers had contact with a female subject who was known to them and was also known to not possess a bartender's license. The female subject indicated a licensed bartender was upstairs. Officers had contact with this person and this person indicated he/she had been sleeping due to his/her work schedule. The bartender and bar owner were both cited.

### **[10-1288] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related**

Tomah Officers were informed of a disturbance that took place at The Bank Bar. The investigation revealed that a female subject entered The Bank Bar to argue with a male subject. The female subject eventually struck the male subject and continued to create a disturbance. The male subject and the female subject had both been consuming alcohol and were both actively involved in the disturbance. The female subject submitted to a

PBT and the result was .198 BAC. The male and female subjects were cited and released. Upon being released, the male subject entered The Bank Bar and was screaming, yelling, cursing and creating another disturbance. The male subject was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail. At the Jail the male subject submitted to a PBT and the result was .197 BAC.

**[10-1343] Robbery of Financial Institution**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to The Farmers and Merchants Bank-North Branch for a reported robbery. Additional information was that the suspect would be at a location near the bank. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect. The suspect was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was eventually interviewed admitting to the robbery. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**Theft from Motor vehicles:** During the month of June there were 24 vehicle entries that were reported. In almost all of these reported cases the vehicles were left unsecured and unattended. The Tomah Police Department urges the Citizens of Tomah to lock your vehicle(s) when unattended.

**COMMENDATIONS**

A special thanks go to Police Clerk Pat Morris. Pat retired on July 1, 2010. We appreciate the time that Pat spent with the Department.

Sgt. Holum, Officer Hintz, Schneider and Kenworthy competed in the Warrior Dash in Joliet, IL. The Warrior Dash is a grueling obstacle course held on some of the nation's most demanding and unique terrain. The officers participated in the Midwest Region Warrior Dash. Seven thousand participants conquered extreme obstacles and rough terrain. Officer Kenworthy finished 4<sup>th</sup> in his age bracket.
