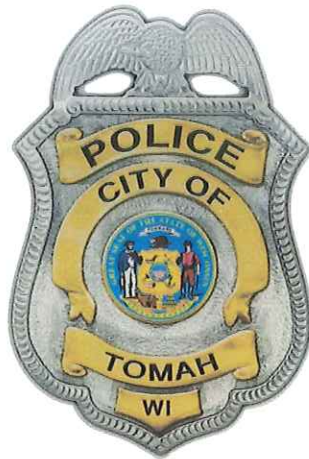

## **OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of June, 2012 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Attended Municipal Court as the court officer.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 192 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month.

Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Assisted in the facilitation of the department's social media networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

Attended the department training held at the High Risk Entry Facility (HREF) located at Volk Field.

Attended the first week of a three week course, Leadership in Police Organizations (LPO). The LPO course is designed to teach Police Leaders how to close the gap between the requirements and goals of the police department and the needs and abilities of the employees that work within it.

Assumed command of the Department in the absence of Chief Revels while he was on vacation.

Attended training sponsored by the FBI. The training was held at the Wisconsin State Patrol Academy and provided information related to the lessons learned during incidents when law enforcement officers were killed or assaulted in the line of duty.

### **COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT**

#### **Call Out:**

#### **Training:**

The Combined Tactical Unit met at Ft. McCoy and visited their South training site. This is the training site where the PATRIOT '12 exercise will be held on July 19. After viewing the training site the Unit moved to Sparta Police Department where Sergeant Weaver briefed the team on upcoming training, Officer Nelson conducted classroom training on the Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TC<sup>3</sup>) protocol including review on use of tourniquets and applying Israeli bandages. Sergeant Weaver then conducted a review on the use of chemical agent protective masks. The Unit then moved to the Gospel Baptist Church where they conducted hands on training related to officer down rescue and K-9 searches.

## TRAINING

Lt. Nicholson is attending Leadership in Police Organizations (LPO).

Administrative Assistant Rhonda Culpitt attended Law Enforcement Administrative Professional (LEAP).

Officer Furlano attended Stinger Instructor Certification (Stinger is a manufacturer of the tire deflation device used by the department).

Officer Jones attended a specialized sniper training practical course.

All sworn personnel attended training at the Volk Field High Risk Entry Facility (HREF), working on close quarter combat drills, movement and clearing of buildings.

Lieutenant Nicholson, Lieutenant Waddell, Sergeant Weaver, Sergeant Huneck and Officer Walters attended Law Enforcement Officer Killed/Assaulted (LEOKA) training at Fort McCoy.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **[12-1169] Disorderly Conduct, Resisting Arrest, Battery, Probation Hold**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on the 200 block of West Milwaukee Street. for a disturbance between a male and female. Officers arrived and began to speak with the male subject. As Officers were trying to obtain identification from the male subject he turned and began running. The subject was controlled with an Electronic Control Device (ECD). The subject refused to comply with numerous orders and was physically resisting arrest. The subject was eventually taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[12-1190] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol related**

Tomah Officers responded to an address on the 1200 block of Butts Avenue for a disturbance. Officers arrived and determined there was a family altercation that resulted in several family members being involved in a fight. All of these subjects were highly intoxicated. Each party involved was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related and released.

**[12-1225] Abuse of Hazardous Substance, Bail Jumping, Obstructing an Officer**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on the 100 block of East Veterans Street for a subject who was sleeping in a garage. Officers arrived and observed a male subject 'huffing' spray paint inside the garage. This subject provided a false name to Police. The subject is currently on bond out of Monroe County and was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[12-1226] Possession of a Synthetic Cannabinoid, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of a Prescription Drug without a Prescription**

Tomah Officers responded to an address on the 1300 block of Butts Avenue for a disturbance. Officers arrived and determined there was an argument but the situation was now calm. Officers had contact with a female subject who was in possession of a synthetic cannabinoid, drug paraphernalia and a partial suboxone tablet. The female subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[12-1235] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Drugged, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Probation Hold**

Tomah Officers responded to an address on Grassman Street for an EMS Assist. Upon arrival Officers began evaluating a male subject that was previously unresponsive. Officers learned that a male subject had fled the residence just prior to Officers arriving. Officers learned that the unresponsive male subject had recently smoked marijuana and had been consuming wine. The Officers believed there was something more ingested that was causing the lethargic and unresponsive behavior. The subject that fled the residence was located and arrested for operating a motor vehicle while drugged. He was also arrested for possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia that was located inside the residence. The male subject was eventually transported to the Monroe County Jail for a probation hold.
