CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of June 2013, by Lt. Mark Nicholson:

Assumed command of the department due to the retirement of Chief Revels.

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 147 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month. Monitored and processed dispositions of cases in which evidence is to be disposed of.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Assumed Incident Command responsibilities for an incident which occurred on Woodard Avenue in which a subject who was wanted on a Wisconsin Department of Corrections warrant barricaded himself inside a residence.

Assisted in the facilitation of the department's Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

Attended the swearing-in ceremony for the department's newest member, Officer Daniel Downey.

Attended bi-weekly staff meetings with the Mayor, City Administrator and other Department heads.

Administered the department's activities and functions related to providing Law Enforcement services for the Tomah Tractor Pull.

Attended a Workman's Comp meeting/training session with other Department Supervisors.

Attended a meeting with Forward Tomah and the Long Range Planning Committee to discuss future land acquisition for business development.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

Shift Supervisor on many of my scheduled shifts.

Performed Time Agency Coordinator responsibilities.

Facilitated the patrol and supervisor training schedules.

Continued weekly checks and cleaning of the drug drop box in the lobby.

Attended to all building/facilities issues as required.

As the Evidence Custodian I facilitated return of evidence/found property to owners, as well as copying evidence CD's and DVD's.

Provided fleet maintenance oversight and assisted in the scheduling of repairs. A new patrol SUV has been added to the fleet. Squad #73 will be decommissioned with all useable equipment being transferred over to the new SUV. The new squad (#43) has been completed and added to the fleet.

Supervised Field Training Officer Program discussions.

Personnel Complaint #13-03 has been assigned for investigation, which is proceeding as directed.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

TRAINING REVIEW:

Training was conducted at Volk Field and consisted of the Leadership Development Course in the morning and entry work at the High Risk Entry Facility in the afternoon. The Leadership Development Course provided the team, in two groups, to conduct a series of challenging obstacles using team skills.

At the High Risk Entry Facility team members conducted four simulated search warrant entries – two on an apartment setting and two on motel rooms. Team members planned, executed and then debriefed the entries.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT CALL OUTS:

TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT TACTICAL CALL OUTS:

June 26 – 508 Woodard Ave. Tomah Police Department personnel went to the location on a follow up investigation. Upon arrival officers learned that a subject who was wanted by the Department of Corrections was upstairs in the house. Officers were unable to locate the suspect and determined that he had entered a small closet with access to the attic area of the house. Tactical team members from the Tomah Police Department were on-duty and other tactical team members responded from off-duty to assist. A plan was developed to use a pike pole from the Tomah Fire Department to remove some items from the closet in an attempt to locate the suspect and if the suspect was not located to introduce chemical agents into the attic area. Upon removing items from the closet officers observed a portion of the suspect's body and ordered the suspect to come out. The suspect complied and was arrested without incident.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

June 1

Graduation.

Assisted Monroe County with taking subject into custody after graduation ceremony.

June 3

Follow up with a parent in regards to injuries her child received at school. Parent believes it is a bullying issue, but the school has accident reports documenting the injuries during sport practices/games. Child insists there is no issue and injuries are legitimate.

Stood by with staff while they spoke with a student who was very irate.

June 4

Spoke with a student in regards to a theft complaint where shoes were stolen from the locker room.

Spoke with a 4th grade student who stole something while on a school field trip. Child was escorted back to the business and made to return the item and apologize. Student was also counseled. Later spoke with mom who will be bringing child to the police department for a follow up visit on June 5th while the child is suspended from school.

June 5

Met with the child from the previous day's theft. I explained to the child what the process may be in the future.

Spoke with a parent in regards to their student running away the previous week and being absent from school. Parent requested truancy citations.

June 6th

Attended National Night Out planning meeting.

Spoke with a student at Robert Kupper in regards to a possible sexual assault. Student denied anything happening.

Picked up a student in regards to a capias. Student transported to court via a transport team.

Spoke with a student in regards to possibly being in possession of contra band. Partial search completed and nothing located. Later spoke with parents who came to complain about their child being searched and their belief this was a violation. School policy was explained to them.

Served citations to two students for truancy.

Arranged for Monroe County Officer to interview a student at Tomah High School.

June 7

Responded to Tomah Middle School for a disturbance with a child. Child released to a parent and a referral made to human services.

TRAINING

Administrative Assistant Rhonda Culpitt attended the annual LEAP (Law Enforcement Administrative Professionals) conference. She was the co-chair of this year's conference which was attended by 110 law enforcement administrative professionals from five different states.

INVESTIGATIONS

13-0911] **Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Restricted Controlled Substance, Obstructing an Officer**
Tomah Officers received information from the Monroe County Sheriff's Department concerning a traffic complaint. A Tomah Officer located the vehicle and subsequently had contact with the operator in the McDonald's parking lot. The female operator provided a false name to Officers. The female operator was under the influence of something and was literally having two different conversations with two imaginary people. The female operator was taken into custody on suspicion of operating a motor

vehicle while under the influence of a controlled substance. The female operator was transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a legal blood draw.

[13-0931] Possession of Methamphetamine, Department of Corrections Warrant

Tomah Officers conducted a traffic stop on the belief a wanted subject was an occupant. Officers confirmed the wanted subject was in the vehicle and he was taken into custody. Officers conducted a pat down search of the operator and located suspected methamphetamine. A probable cause search of the vehicle resulted in locating additional methamphetamine. Two passengers were arrested and the operator will have charges referred to the District Attorney's Office.

[13-0955] Disorderly Conduct While Armed

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the area of Kwik Trip North for a report of a disturbance. Additionally, Officers were informed that several citizens were chasing the suspect towards McDonald's. An Officer arrived on scene and began to chase the suspect. The suspect was caught and taken into custody. Officers learned that the male suspect had threatened another person with a knife. Officers also learned that the suspect had attempted to punch and kick the citizens who were trying to prevent him from leaving. The suspect was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-1040] Felon in Possession of Firearm

Tomah Officers responded to an address on Butts Ave. to assist the Tomah Area Ambulance Service. Officers learned a male subject had sustained a severe injury to his upper left leg. Details surrounding the injury were suspicious and information obtained from the injured person led Officers to believe the injury may be from a firearm. Officers determined the injured person was a convicted felon and he admitted to possessing a firearm. The suspect was transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital where he received numerous sutures to close the wound. Officers obtained a search warrant for the residence and located numerous firearms. The suspect was treated, released and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-1044] Encouraging Violation of Parole or Probation

Tomah Officers were conducting a follow-up investigation into a theft on the 500 block of Woodard Ave. While at this location Officers learned there was a wanted subject inside the residence. Officers attempted contact with the subject and determined he had fled into an attic crawl space. Tomah Officers were eventually able to locate the wanted subject hiding in the crawl space. The subject was taken into custody without further incident.
