### **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES**

I attended the Department Head staff meetings with the Mayor and City Administrator.

### **COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT**

#### **CALLOUT:**

March 14, 2012

100 block Morse Street, Sparta – High Risk Search Warrant

CTU was requested by the Sparta Police Department to serve a High Risk Search Warrant on a location where crack cocaine sales were occurring. CTU conducted a rather quick briefing and planning session in order to serve the warrant prior to the end of the school day. Search warrant was served and one subject was detained and turned over to the investigators.

#### **TRAINING:**

March 28, 2012

High Risk Entry Facility, Volk Field

CTU Training was held at the High Risk Entry Facility at Volk Field and consisted of the following:

Debrief of Morse Street, Sparta High Risk Search Warrant.

Breaching training for new team members including integrating the breacher into the entry team utilizing breaching practice doors.

Flashbang deployment for new team members including integrating the deployment of a flashbang in the entry team and “no bang” scenarios.

High Risk Search Warrant service training; planning the mission and then executing the plan with role players.

Hostage Rescue scenarios; deploying immediate action team and responding to fluid situation.

## SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

### **March 8**

Officers had contact with an unruly student at Lemonwier School. Officers assisted parent in removing the student and placing student into her vehicle.

While at Lemonwier School I was asked to look at an injury of a student who was stabbed with a pencil. Later I spoke with the parent of the injured student in regards to the reason I was talking to the student.

Meeting with Middle School staff and parents of a student who had some writings that were of concern.

Contact with a staff member in regards to assisting a pregnant student with a car seat.

### **March 9**

Spoke with the suspects in regards to the damage to property complaint. One to be cited for Damage to Property and the other for Party to a Crime. Also spoke with the parents of the suspects and advised them they would be receiving citations.

Spoke with the victim in regards to their vehicle. Advised them that they needed to turn in their statement so I could continue with this case.

Spoke with the parent of a female student concerned about an adult male contacting her. I later spoke with the student as well.

Spoke with a staff member in regards to family concerns a student brought up. Advised Monroe County that a possible bond violation is occurring.

Spoke with a student in regards to the theft of their bicycle. Step brother took the bike and sold the parts from it.

Contact with a student refusing to follow school rules. Student eventually left and will be cited for Disorderly Conduct.

Contact with a staff member at Miller School in regards to some things occurring at school.

### **March 13**

Conversation with the parent of a 17 year old and concerns about their behavior.

Meet with teen parents in regards to car seat safety.

Request made by staff members to assist them with a student.

Assisted the Investigator in regards to interviewing a student at school.

Assisted Middle School with interviewing students in regards to a theft.

### **March 14**

Attended Interdepartmental Training.

Spoke with the parents of one of the Middle School students who were interviewed the previous day.

Spoke with Principal at Robert Kupper Learning Center in regards to the break in.

Served citations for Damage to Property.

Follow up with Middle School staff in regards to interviews the previous day.

### **March 15**

Served citations to students for Damage to Property and Disorderly Conduct.

Spoke with several parents of Middle School students in regards to theft and other issues at the Middle School.

Investigated accident in parking lot of High School.

Assisted staff at the Middle School in regards to trying to locate students missing from class.

Attempted follow up in regards to Robert Kupper Learning Center break in.

Completed reports at the police department.

Spoke with a student at Lemonwier School who was disruptive. We were eventually able to make contact with a parent who came and picked up the student.

Spoke with a student at Tomah Middle School in regards to their disruptive behavior.

Information received in regards to a student selling pills at Tomah High School. A search was conducted and the student was found in possession of marijuana. Citation to be issued. Quick \$50 was paid out.

Spoke with a student in regards to a theft from the cafeteria. Student to be cited for theft.

Spoke with a student in regards to the break in at Robert Kupper Learning Center.

Found I-pod.

Referral for truancy received.

Spoke at High School Health Classes.

Theft complaint from cafeteria, student later cited.

Spoke with sexual assault victim.

## **TRAINING**

Lt. Nicholson and Officer Jones attended a Social Networking presentation, with a focus on creating policy.

## CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Joe Libowsky, the Coordinator for the Wisconsin Crime Alert Network, and I were interviewed by Greg Hagen from the Hagen Sports Network and Brittany Linenberg from the Tomah Journal. The Wisconsin Crime Alert Network was the interview topic.

The Department held a meeting with some of the City of Tomah Alcohol Licensees. The attendees were provided information related to the Use of Force decision making by Law Enforcement.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### **12-0537] Sexual Assault-2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Exposing Genitals to Child, False Imprisonment, Sexual Intercourse with a Child 16 or over, Strangulation and Suffocation**

Tomah Officers spoke with a 17-year-old female victim of a sexual assault that allegedly occurred with a 22-year-old male. The investigation revealed that the victim was at her cousin's apartment and was watching their small child. Her cousin's husband was supposed to be at the residence but due to a work schedule would be sleeping throughout the day. The victim stated the husband awoke and began to make verbal and physical advances towards the victim. The victim stated that she was forced to kiss the suspect and perform fellatio along with other sexual contacts. The suspect was located at an address in Juneau County and spoke with an Officer over the phone. The suspect spoke briefly before hanging up on the Officer. A request was sent to Juneau County Sheriff's Department to locate and arrest the suspect. The suspect was located and taken into custody.

### **[12-0562] Sexual Assault to a Child by School Staff/Person, Child Enticement**

Tomah Officers investigated a sexual assault complaint that involved a 17-year-old female and a 37-year-old male. The 17-year-old female victim alleges that her driving instructor had hugged her, kissed her and rubbed his genitalia on her. Tomah Officers interviewed the suspect and were able to substantiate most of the allegations. The suspect was taken to the Monroe County Jail and charged with two felonies associated with Sexual Assault of a Child.

### **[12-0564] Possession of a Schedule III Drug, Possession of a Schedule IV Drug, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of a Prescription Drug without a Prescription, Theft**

Tomah Officers were requested at the Greyhound Bus Depot for a theft complaint. Officers arrived and met with a female victim. The victim stated she was on the bus and awoke to someone going through her purse. The victim was able to identify several people that were alleged to have been involved in the theft. During the contact with these people Officers located a black bag that contained syringes, alcohol wipes and other items that are commonly associated with intravenous drug use. Officers took a male and



a female subject into custody for the theft and drug related charges. Both subjects were transported to the Monroe County Jail. The purse was located in the bathroom on the bus and was returned to the owner.

**[12-0578] Strangulation/Suffocation, False Imprisonment, Battery, Disorderly Conduct, Resisting Arrest, Violation of 72 hour no contact**

Tomah Officers met with a female subject at the Tomah Police Department. The female subject indicated she was just involved in a domestic violence situation with her boyfriend. The female subject stated she was hit and choked during the altercation and the male suspect/boyfriend refused to let her leave. The female subject had their 2-year-old child and the male subject pushed her while she was holding the child. The female subject was eventually able to flee from the residence with the child. Tomah Officers are familiar with the male subject from prior Police contacts. Tomah Officers proceeded to the residence with the intent of taking the male subject into custody. Officer arrived and attempted contact but the male subject refused to answer the door. The female subject had given Officers consent to enter the property and a door was breached to facilitate entry. Several Officers and K-9 Jager were able to safely take the male subject into custody. The male subject refused to cooperate and became physically resistive when Officers were attempting to place him in a squad car. Officers were able to get the male subject into the car and he was then transported to the Monroe County Jail. While the subject was at the jail he called the victim at least four times. All charges have been sent to the Monroe County District Attorney's Office.
