OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of March, 2013 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests' made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 95 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month. Monitored and processed dispositions of cases in which evidence is to be disposed of.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Completed an investigation into the use of force by a Tomah Officer. Ultimately it was determined that the alleged misconduct did not occur and was false. The

subject that filed the complaint was cited for Filing a False Complaint of Misconduct.

Administered the hiring process for the next full time patrol position.

Assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

Attended Administrative Command Staff meeting held at the Tomah Police Department.

Participated in the hiring process for the Data Entry Clerk position.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of March, 2013 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

During this month I continued as a shift supervisor on many of my shifts.

Continued efforts in performing Time Agency Coordinator duties.

Attended Administrative Staff meeting.

Handled building maintenance issues.

The task of Fleet Maintenance Commander resulted in taking cars for routine and non-routine maintenance. Squad #78 sustained damage, which resulted in receiving repair estimates, and ultimately scheduling the needed repairs to the exterior. New emergency lights were ordered and installed in the Investigator #2 car. By doing this work ourselves the department saw a savings of \$425.00 above the quoted amount by Communications Services.

Reminder - The next planned National Take Back date is April 27, 2013 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Due to the overwhelming amounts that have been brought into the police department, Administrative Assistant Culpitt will be organizing volunteers to help organize and discard the medications currently being held.

I continue to serve on the Expanded District Facilities Meeting for the school district, with a focus on evaluating current building safety practices, then recommending changes where appropriate.

Lieutenant Nicholson and I continue to provide oversight with all items related to the evidence room, to include incoming and outgoing evidence, copying of evidence CD's and DVD's. One case in particular of interest was a case that allowed us (via an evidence

release from the District Attorney) to release hundreds of items back to the victim in a major theft case. The removal of this case from the evidence room has opened up a complete wall of shelving. There are still a large number of cases to be researched and the property returned or destroyed.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

CALL OUT:

Millstone Avenue, rural Wilton. Monroe County Sheriff Department personnel requested CTU response for an armed suicidal subject. Further information was provided that the subject was living in a camper trailer at the end of a long downhill driveway and the subject was contacted in the past week and was armed at that time. CTU responded to the call and met with the Sheriff's Department supervisor at the Wilton Police Department for further briefing. Attempts to contact the subject via cellular telephone were unanswered at this point. A plan was developed for CTU personnel to approach the residence on foot from approximately ½ mile away using available woods for cover and concealment. Once in place various tactics could be employed to elicit a response from the subject and initiate communication with the Sheriff's Department personnel via cellular telephone. As CTU personnel were establishing their inner perimeter the subject returned a call to the Sheriff's Department personnel and engaged in conversation. A short time later the subject agreed to exit the residence and the subject was detained by CTU personnel without further incident.

TRAINING:

Training for March was conducted at Volk Field as a joint training with the La Crosse County Sheriff's Department Emergency Response Team (ERT), which is staffed by members of the La Crosse County Sheriff's Department and Onalaska Police Department. The first portion of the training consisted of firearms training with both pistol and rifle. During the pistol course of fire standards were established and eight of ten shots fired were required to hit the designated zone. No TPD personnel had any difficulty with meeting the standard. During the rifle course of fire several barricades were positioned to force shooters to fire from awkward and challenging firing positions. The remainder of the day was spent conducting exercises at the rural training village. La Crosse County ERT personnel briefed us on their explosive breaching program and our team members were able to participate in several explosive breaches during the day. Additionally, I conducted familiarization training, including driving, on the BEARCAT armored rescue vehicle with CTU personnel who had not yet had the opportunity to drive the armored vehicle. Tactical K-9 training with Officer Hintz and K-9 Jager was also conducted including on-leash searches with extraction from a hidden position, window entries and a window extraction. Lastly, we combined both teams to conduct a hostage rescue exercise with role players. A very compressed timeline for planning, briefing and execution was used and both teams performed very well together.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

INVESTIGATIONS

[13-0472] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated, Obstructing an Officer

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was traveling the wrong way on a divided highway. The operator displayed signs of impairment and smelled of intoxicants. The Officer attempted to conduct Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) but the operator was too intoxicated to follow instructions and eventually refused to take any tests. The subject was administered a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) and the result was .186 BAC, which confirmed the Officer's suspicion that the impairment was due to alcohol consumption. The operator was arrested and transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a legal blood draw. While at the hospital the operator became physically combative with the Officer and the Officer was forced to summons additional help from other Law Enforcement personnel. The operator refused to cooperate with the Officer and attempted to move from his chair and stand up. The operator was instructed to remain seated but physically pushed against the Officer. The Officer deployed his department issued Electronic Control Device (ECD) and instructed the operator to remain seated and calm down. The operator decided to cooperate. Once assistance arrived, the Tomah Officer was able to complete the processing and then took the subject to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-0484] Shoplifting

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Kwik Trip South for a reported theft complaint. Officers arrived and learned that a female subject had entered the store and filled her purse with hot sandwiches and left the store. The female subject was located seated inside a vehicle still parked in the parking lot. The female subject was highly intoxicated and was eating the sandwiches. The Officers were able to locate seven sandwiches inside her purse. The female subject was cited and released.

[13-0489] Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Warrant Arrest

Tomah Officers were conducting bond monitoring checks at an address on the 600 block of Superior Ave. The Officers observed a pipe commonly used to smoke marijuana in plain view on a table. The Officer determined the owner of the pipe and this person was cited. Another person inside the residence was determined to have a warrant and was taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-0483] Bail Jumping, Resisting Arrest, Criminal Trespass to a Dwelling

Tomah Officers were dispatched to an address on Pine St. for a reported burglary in progress. Officers arrived and were met by three suspects. Two suspects were running from a camper that was in the backyard and another tried leaving through the front door of the residence. All three subjects were taken into custody and determined to not have permission to be on the property or in any structure on the property. All three suspects were arrested and taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-0496] Public Nuisance (Urinating in Public), Resisting an Officer

A Tomah Officer was patrolling the downtown bar district and observed a male subject urinating on the side of a building. The Officer exited his squad car and approached the male subject. The Officer announced his presence and the male subject looked at the Officer and began running. The male subject didn't take time to zip his zipper and began to run from the Officer. The subject was taken into custody in front of Dimension's Bar. The subject was issued citations and released.

[13-0499] Possession of a Synthetic Cannabinoid, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Bail Jumping (Felony)

An Officer was conducting follow-up and parked behind the Crow Bar. The Officer observed a male subject seated in a vehicle and once this subject realized a Police Officer was looking at him he began to hide items in the center console. Contact was made with the subject and he admitted to possessing a synthetic cannabinoid and provided the Officer with the contraband. The subject will be referred to the District Attorney's Office for charges.
