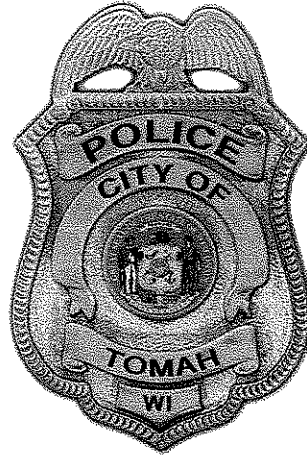


# **TOMAH POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS**

## **CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES**

I met with Chief Decorah, Justin Sommerfelt and Dan Gossman and discussed our Severe Weather Warning System.

I met with Mayor Rusch, Charlotte and Doug Mallory and their son regarding the violation of an ordinance related to the housing of dogs.

Sgt. Pedersen and I met with Calvin Broas to discuss Broas' intention on forming a motorcycle club called the "Stone Creed Riders".

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition.

I attended a meeting of the Our Town Tomah group.

I attended the last meeting of the school year for the Interact youth leadership group at Tomah Senior High. Rotary sponsored a continental breakfast in honor of all Interact students and presented a rose to the graduating seniors.

I attended a meeting of the Coulee Region Law Enforcement Executive Group.

I conducted an Administrative Staff meeting.

Lieutenant's Nicholson and Waddell and I meet with representatives from the Grand National Tractor Pull. We meet annually prior to the event for the purpose of reviewing the event and discussing changes.

I conducted a Command Staff meeting.

Completed requests' made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room.

Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence.

Attended a meeting with the Monroe County Agriculture Society. The meeting was to plan and prepare for the upcoming Grand National Tractor Pull to be held June 23, 24, 25 and 26.

Completed grant paperwork and activities related to the Nuisance Abatement Vehicle, the Speed Radar Sign and the CARD Grant.

Attended a command staff meeting, an administrative meeting, and a Wellness/Fitness Committee meeting.

Facilitated the completion of the weapon exchange with Moe's (Black River Falls), and then added same to department inventory.

Attended a Command Staff meeting.

Conducted a death investigation and assisted at another death investigation.

Attended the annual Tomah Police Department Award Ceremony.

Attended and participated in a Command Staff meeting.

Facilitated all training related events for department staff.

Currently reviewing and making necessary changes to several departmental policies and procedures.

Participated in reading for Project Wisdom at the Tomah Middle School.

### **COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT**

Monroe County Combined Tactical Unit Training Report - 06/01/11

Training was held at the Monroe County Range and consisted of zeroing weapons and working on vehicle takedown SOP. Sgt. Ames made arrangements for two cars to be at the range for use during the training and we also conducted test firing of pistol and rifle through the windshield, from the inside out. We determined that both TPD pistol and rifle duty ammunition was reasonably accurate when fired through the windshield at a target. We did not have a means available to test the retained terminal ballistic capability of the projectiles that did strike the target. Training concluded with a live fire full speed sniper initiated hostage rescue vehicle takedown.

### **SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER ACTIVITIES**

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of May, 2011 by Officer Marshall, the School Resource Officer:

Officer Marshall and Sgt. Huneck provided information related to law enforcement and a tour of the Police Department to some Tomah Middle School students during the Middle School Career Day.

Officer Marshall gave presentations to the Health classes at Tomah Senior High.

The G.R.E.A.T. program was completed with close to 250 6<sup>th</sup> graders graduating. The G.R.E.A.T. program was taught at the Tomah Middle School along with St. Mary's School.

The following enforcement actions were taken:

12 habitual truancy citations issued; 1 truancy citation issued.

1 disorderly conduct contact due to a fight between two students. Both were issued municipal citations for Disorderly Conduct.

1 disorderly conduct contact due to a student bringing a knife to school. A referral to Human Services was sent.

2 thefts of I-Pods. Three students were cited for Theft.

2 tobacco violations. Three students were cited for Tobacco Possession.

## TRAINING

Officer Brittnay Westpfahl attended the Division of Criminal Investigation's Death Investigation School from May 9th – 20th, 2011 in Green Lake County

The Department sponsored Threat Liaison Officer training, which was well attended by many area agencies. Lieutenant Nicholson, Sergeant Weaver, Sergeant Pedersen, and Officer Furlano attended this training for the Tomah Police Department.

## CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Investigator Walensky presented a block of instruction on fraud and scams. The presentation was completed at the request of the First Bank of Tomah. There were about twenty-one attendees.

Sgt. Eric Pedersen presented a block of instruction on Active Shooters to a group of Human Resource professionals. Bonnie Reekie from Usemco coordinated the training with the Department.

## INVESTIGATIONS

### [11-0839] Disorderly Conduct/Possession of Prescription Medication without a Prescription

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Kwik Trip north for a report of two subjects that weren't wanted on the property. Officer removed the subjects. A couple hours later Officers were dispatched to Wal-Mart for a report of a male subject creating a disturbance. Officers arrived on scene and located the male subject from the earlier call. This male subject had been harassing a couple subjects who were trying to sell baked goods outside the store. The male subject was taken into custody. The subject was in possession of prescription medication and did not have a prescription. The subject was cited and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

### [11-0841] False Imprisonment/Possession of Marijuana/Disorderly

Conduct/Theft/Possession of Prescription Medication without a Prescription  
Tomah Officers were contacted by a female victim who lives on the 1100 block of Superior Ave. The victim indicated her boyfriend had created a disturbance and prevented her from calling the Police. Officers proceed to the area and had a description of the male subject. Tomah Officers were informed that a Wisconsin

State Patrol Trooper was in a foot pursuit a male subject matching the description. Tomah Officers located and arrested the male subject. The male subject was in possession of marijuana and a prescription medication that he did not have a prescription for. The male subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**[11-0864] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol/Obstructing an Officer**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Callahan's bar for a report of a male subject who had broken a beer bottle and was throwing bar stools. Officers arrived and spoke with several patrons and the bartender, all indicated nothing happened. Officers then spoke with the person that called the Police and were given a description of the involved subjects; one of the involved subjects was in the bar and had initially told Police that nothing happened. Officer spoke with this subject and he admitted that he did break a beer bottle and toss a couple bar stools. Officers issued this subject a citation and he was released. Officers issued the bartender a citation for knowingly providing false information to the Police (Obstructing). The bar tender was not cooperative, was rude and used profanity during the contact with the Police.

**[11-0912] Use/Abuse Hazardous Substance/Bail Jumping**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the area near Pizza Hut and Ho-Chunk Cinema for a report of a male subject looking into vehicles. Officers arrived and located a male subject. This male subject had silver paint around his nose and mouth and indicated he had been huffing spray paint. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Monroe County Jail. Officers were able to determine that this male subject was the person looking into vehicles.

**[11-0915] Shoplifting/Bail Jumping/Possession of Marijuana**

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Burnstad's Supermarket for a report of a shoplifter. Officers arrived and were informed that the subject had fled on foot. Officers located the subject walking behind the Aquatic Center and he was taken into custody. The subject was identified as the person who shoplifted. The Officers located marijuana on the subject. The subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

**COMMENDATIONS**

On May 18<sup>th</sup>, the Department held our Annual awards banquet. This year we had just one recipient, Officer Paul Sloan.

**The Tomah Police Department's Meritorious Arrest Citation is presented to Officer Paul Sloan.**

**On August 2, 2009 at approximately 8:53 a.m. officers responded to the 300 block of Hollister Avenue for the report of a possible burglary. Upon arrival officers located a residence on fire. At that time Officer Sloan was assigned as the primary officer for this incident.**

**Over the course of the next seventeen months Officer Sloan worked closely with DCI and ATF personnel, gathering evidence, conducting interviews and continuing the investigation into the suspicious nature of this fire.**

**As a result of the evidence gathered and investigative follow up, a federal arrest warrant was obtained and successfully served upon a male subject for the arson of this residence.**

The Walmart Supercenter manager, Richard Owens presented a certificate and cake to members of the Department to express their appreciation for the exceptional work we do for them and the community.

My thanks go out to Investigator Rob Walensky in recognition of the work that he did on the Vance Evans homicide. Investigator Walensky's major case final work product is second to none.
