OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's Office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures.

Attended Municipal Court as the court officer.

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Attended a Command Staff meeting.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 130 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month.

Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

Attended a training session, Bulletproof Mind, sponsored by the Department of Justice. Bulletproof Mind was instructed by Lt. Colonel Dave Grossman. Lt. Col. Grossman is an internationally recognized scholar, author, soldier, and speaker who is one of the world's foremost experts in the field of human aggression and the roots of violence and violent crime.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

Shift Supervisor on many of my scheduled shifts.

Performed Time Agency Coordinator responsibilities.

Facilitated the patrol and supervisor training schedules.

Continued weekly checks and cleaning of the drug drop box in the lobby.

Attended to all building/facilities issues as required.

As the Evidence Custodian I facilitated return of evidence/found property to owners.

Provided fleet maintenance oversight and assisted in the scheduling of repairs.

Supervised Field Training Officer Program discussions.

Attended Command Staff Meeting.

Attended communications meeting in Sparta, with a main topic specific to the current changeover to narrowband and the problems all public safety elements are having subsequent to this change. Communications Services provided an overview of the problems in the county (which is lack of towers/repeaters) and a probable solution.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Call Out:

On May 4, 2012 Monroe County Combined Tactical Unit served two search warrants on Wolcott St. in the City of Sparta. The suspects in the investigation were believed to have been involved in selling and using drugs, possessing illegal and stolen firearms, and possessing stolen property. One of the suspects was known to carry a firearm in a holster around his house and both locations had exterior surveillance cameras. Significant planning and preparation resulted in the successful use of a ruse to apprehend the suspect outside of his residence. The remainder of the tactical team then arrived and served the search

warrant on the first residence. The suspect at the second residence came outside and was apprehended by perimeter personnel. Combined Tactical Unit personnel then served the search warrant on the second location.

Training:

Training was conducted at the Monroe County Fairgrounds and at the Tomah Municipal Airport property. The first four hours of training was a joint training with Jackson County Sheriff's Department Emergency Response Team and K-9 (Bloodhound and Patrol) Units. Several K-9 tracks utilizing Bloodhounds with Patrol K-9 backup were conducted. Monroe County CTU personnel then participated in a review of small unit movement tactics and a non-K-9 wooded area search. Finally, an AAR of the Wolcott St. search warrants and a briefing on the Patriot '12 Exercise was conducted at Tomah PD.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

In recognition of National Law Enforcement Week the Tomah Citizen's Academy Alumni Association provided free hot dogs and soda on Friday, May 11, 2012.

Our Annual Awards Ceremony was held Wednesday, May 16, 2012. This year there were three recipients of the Chief's Award, two Citizen's Citations recipients, two Lifesavings Award recipients, four Medal of Valor Award recipients and one Purple Heart Award recipient.

INVESTIGATIONS

[12-0958] Substantial Battery, Intimidation of a Victim/Witness, False Imprisonment, Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Police received information concerning a battery complaint between a husband and wife. The investigation revealed that a disturbance took place on Glendale Avenue that resulted in the husband and wife being in the same vehicle together. While in the vehicle the husband punched the wife in the nose, breaking it. The victim tried getting out of the vehicle but the husband would not stop. Eventually the victim was able to leave and get medical attention. The husband was located at a later date and taken into custody on several felony charges.

[12-0983] Violation of Absolute Sobriety, Underage Alcohol Possession

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. The investigation revealed the operator, a 17-year-old female, had been consuming alcohol. The female submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .06 BAC. The female was taken into custody and processed for Violation of Absolute Sobriety. A passenger in the vehicle was cited for Underage Alcohol Possession.

[12-0986] Disorderly Conduct, Battery, Resisting Arrest, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Grandview Avenue for a reported physical fight in the street. Prior to Officer arrival the suspects quit fighting and separated. One of the suspects was located walking on East Veterans Street. This suspect indicated he was in a fight but wouldn't name the other involved party. Another Tomah Officer was in contact with the other involved party. This subject refused to cooperate and began fighting with Police. An Electronic Control Device was used to control this subject. Officers determined this subject was intoxicated and had been smoking a synthetic cannabinoid throughout the day. This subject was escorted to a squad car where he repeatedly struck his head on the cage in the vehicle. The subject received a laceration over his eye and began smearing his blood all over the back seat. The subject's behavior was concerning to Officers so he was taken to Tomah Memorial Hospital to be medically cleared. The subject was cleared and taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[12-0990] Violation of Absolute Sobriety, Operating After Suspension, Underage Alcohol Possession

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for suspicion that the operator had a suspended driver's license. The operator was determined to have a suspended driver's license. While the Officer was in contact with the driver the Officer could smell alcohol. A Preliminary Breath Test was administered and the result was .088 BAC. The operator was taken into custody and transported to the Tomah Police Department for processing. The operator was eventually released to a responsible party.

[12-1000] Bail Jumping, Violation of Absolute Sobriety, Reckless Driving, Unreasonable and Imprudent Speed, Underage Alcohol Possession

A vehicle was observed traveling at an estimated speed of 60 MPH on the 600 block of Superior Avenue. The vehicle was stopped and the 20-year-old operator had been consuming alcohol. A Preliminary Breath Test was administered and the result was .216 BAC. The operator maintained that he had not consumed alcohol. The operator is currently on bond out of Monroe County with provisions against

consuming alcohol. The operator was taken into custody and processed for Violation of Absolute Sobriety. The operator was then transported to the Monroe County Jail.
