

INVESTIGATIONS

[13-0533] Disorderly Conduct, Bail Jumping

Tomah Officers were dispatch to an address on Sheri Ct. for a report of a female subject armed with a knife and threatening her husband. Officers arrived and met with the husband. The husband was highly intoxicated and fairly uncooperative even though he called the Police. Officer had contact with several subjects inside the residence to include the wife. The investigation revealed that the husband made up the story to show his wife that he wasn't kidding when he told her he was going to call the Police. The husband admitted he made up the story because in the past his wife has been the one to call the Police and this time he wanted to beat her to it. The husband was taken into custody for creating the disturbance and additionally charged for Bail Jumping as he currently has open criminal cases in Monroe County.

[13-0780] Reckless Driving

An off duty Tomah Officer was traveling east on W. Veterans St. when a vehicle passed him and another vehicle. After passing both vehicles the vehicle forced an oncoming vehicle to take evasive action to avoid a crash. The off duty Officer followed the vehicle to an address on Kozarek St. Officers were informed that the owner's daughter normally drives the vehicle but her daughter was claiming she had loaned the vehicle to a friend. Officers eventually learned the daughter lied to the Police. The daughter later admitted to operating the vehicle.

[13-0814] Physical Abuse to a Child, Bail jumping

Tomah Officers responded to the 800 block of Pearl St. to take a report regarding a battery. Officers arrived and met with the parents of a 15-year-old male juvenile. The male juvenile had been at Winnebago Park and was punched by two other male subjects. The investigation revealed that the male juvenile was at the park when a friend drove up to meet him. When his friend drove into the park he drove past another group of people and allegedly someone said something. Four subjects approached the male juvenile and began to instigate an altercation. The male juvenile told them he didn't want to fight, apologized for his friend and tried leaving. Two adult male subjects then began to punch and beat the male juvenile. The male juvenile believed he was struck in or about the head at least ten times. Both male suspects were located and arrested. Both were taken to the Monroe County Jail.

[13-0815] Discharge of Firearm

Tomah Officers responded to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a report of a subject with a gunshot wound to a leg. Officers arrived and spoke with a male subject who was being treated for a gunshot wound to his lower left leg. The male subject stated he arrived at his residence and was going to transfer his loaded

pistol from his vehicle to the house. The male subject was wearing gym shorts and placed the pistol in the waistline area by his back. The pistol fell to the ground landing on the hammer causing a round to be discharged. No other subjects were injured or near the firearm at the time it discharged.

[13-0822] Recklessly Endangering Safety

Tomah Officers responded to the 100 block of E. Veterans St. for a disturbance. Officers arrived and began to interview the parties involved. Officers learned that a husband and wife had been arguing and another family member became involved. Officers were informed by the wife that she had on two separate occasions chased her husband out of the residence with a knife. The wife indicated on the second instance she actually stabbed her husband in the stomach with enough force to break the knife. The husband confirmed this story but refused to cooperate with pursuing charges. The case will be referred to the Monroe County District Attorney's Office.

[13-0886] Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Tomah Officers responded to Walmart after a citizen reported seeing someone smoking marijuana inside a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle at an address on Evergreen Pass and had contact with the owner. The owner claimed he didn't smoke marijuana and refused to cooperate. K-9 Jager was utilized to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle and produced a positive alert. A subsequent probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted and marijuana and smoking devices were located. The items were seized. The owner was cited and released.
