OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of November, 2012 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

Completed requests made by the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office for copies of evidence related to audio, video and pictures. Managed and processed the open records requests for audio and video related evidence

Conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts.

Assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop off box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

Assumed command of the department in the absence of Chief Revels while he was on vacation.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence, assuring that it was properly packaged and labeled. Once this was completed the evidence was processed into the evidence room. 230 pieces of evidence were processed into the Evidence Room throughout the month.

Attended a TraCS Testing and Evaluation for a new TraCS program that is slated to roll out in April 2013.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members. This task included schedule variations related to comp time, vacation time, court time, training time, sick leave, and special assignments.

Administered and participated in the filling of the Investigator II position. This task included developing a written test and oral interview questions for the investigator candidates. At the conclusion of the process a written recommendation was provided to Chief Revels to assign Officer Sloan to the Investigator II position.

Prepared plans and submitted Wisconsin DOT Detour Permits for the Annual Holiday Parade and the Veterans Memorial event.

Provided oversight/security at City Hall during the Presidential election.

Assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks to include Facebook and Twitter.

Facilitated the Shift Selection and Vacation Selection Process for Patrol and Command staff for the 2013 Calendar year.

COMBINED TACTICAL UNIT

Call Out:

No call outs in November.

Training:

Training was conducted in Tomah and began at the Tomah Police Department before moving to Lagrange School for practical exercises. Training consisted of a team meeting and debrief of the call-out / cancellation in Sparta on 11/16/12. Officer Kuen provided information on the situation and the team discussed methods for resolution of the situation if it had not been resolved prior to CTU arrival. Sgt. Weaver provided an overview of the Multi-Assault Counter Terrorism Action Capabilities training that was held in La Crosse on 11/14/12 to ensure that all CTU personnel have an understanding of the concept, which would primarily be a mutual aid response in this area due to limited resources. Sgt. Weaver also presented a block of instruction on ladder deployments in a tactical setting in the classroom. Practical training took place at Lagrange School in Tomah and we received a briefing on equipment available to us from the Tomah Fire Department, which primarily consisted of breaching tools including a rescue saw, ladders, and air packs. Team members then practiced ladder deployments in small teams at the school using a hand ladder on the small roof and the truck mounted ladder on the high roof. Team members had the opportunity to use a fire hose and also try on a SCBA air pack.

TRAINING

Sergeant Weaver, Sergeant Pedersen and Officer Jones attended a training opportunity in La Crosse on November 14, 2012. The training title, Multi-Assault Counter-Terrorism Action Capabilities (MACTAC), was a developmental training geared toward application of basic skills to deal with multiple assailants through deployment of contact teams with the purpose of neutralizing violent assaults and/or terrorist acts.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Department hosted the first Financial Institution Security Officer Association (F.I.S.O.A.) meeting at the Police Department. There were discussions about current hold-up alarm procedures, contact information was exchanged, and future meetings and topics were discussed once it was determined there was a need for the open exchange of information between the financial institutions. Lieutenant Waddell is working as the department's liaison with this group.

INVESTIGATIONS

[12-2118] Obstructing an Officer, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Bicycle Violations, Warrant

A Tomah officer observed a subject that had a warrant out of the City of Tomah. The Officer attempted to stop the subject, who was riding a bicycle, but the subject instead began to flee from the officer. The subject fled for several blocks, through yards, down alleys and eventually stopped at the backyard area to a residence on the 400 block of Superior Avenue. The subject was located on a porch. The subject had been in possession of a backpack but at the time the subject was taken into custody he no longer had the backpack. The backpack was located along the outside of the porch only a few feet from where the subject was taken into custody. Officers located marijuana and drug paraphernalia inside the backpack. The subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[12-2185] Underage Alcohol Consumption, minor Transporting Alcohol, Violation of GDL restrictions

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for being operated without the headlamps on. The vehicle was occupied by four subjects. During the contact the officer could smell the odor of alcohol coming from the vehicle. Alcoholic beverages and beverage containers were located inside the vehicle. All occupants admitted to consuming alcohol. The Operator admitted to consuming one beer but a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) indicated the subject had no alcohol in his body. Each of the occupants was cited accordingly and all but one was released to a parent. The other occupant was 18-years-old and released on scene.

[12-2247] Bail Jumping-Felony, Possession of Cocaine, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Warrant Arrest

Tomah Officers assisted the Veterans Affairs Police Department with a subject who had a warrant. A female subject was arrested and a subsequent search of her person revealed a small amount of cocaine. The female subject is currently on bond out of Monroe County along with a warrant out of the State of Minnesota for drug charges. The female subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.
