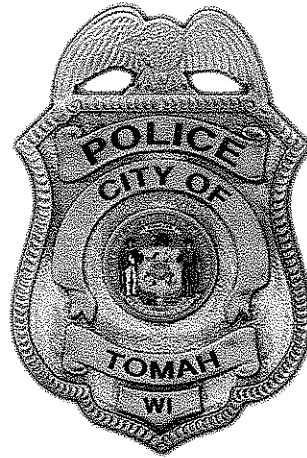

POLICE CHIEF WES REVELS

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

Last month, I informed the Common Council that the Department had applied for and received a \$5,000.00 grant from the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators, Inc. The grant monies were spent as follows: Digital Security Cameras and Accessories, Reconyx, \$1,629.91, MVDR Camera kit and Accessories, Super Circuits, \$1,144.73, updating some existing equipment to digital capability, \$2,224.00. The total amount of these purchases is \$4,998.64.

I attended a meeting of the Western Technical College Advisory Committee.

A few months ago, I informed the Common Council that the Department had applied for a grant from the Office of Justice Assistance for the purpose of equipping a "Nuisance Abatement Vehicle". I am pleased to inform the Council that the Office of Justice Assistance grant review committee has approved a partial grant of up to \$5,546.00 for our Nuisance Abatement Vehicle program. The grant application struck the grant committee as innovative with some potential for enhancing crime prevention and intervention. For that reason, they decided to call our venture a "demonstration project" meaning that the Office of Justice Assistance requests as a Special Condition that our Department keep a log of the unit's use and any success stories that we can document. Our information will provide the Office of Justice Assistance with some usage documentation of this innovation to help with future grants of this sort.

I attended a meeting with representatives of the Our Town Tomah group.

I attended a meeting of the Monroe County Safety Coalition

Administrative Assistant Culpitt and I met with Superintendent Zahrte for the purpose of re-signing a Memorandum of Understanding related to the exchange of information between the Police Department and Tomah School District.

I attended the Dispatch Advisory Committee meeting.

Officer Marshall and I met with Deana Protz, of the Boys and Girls Club. Deana is interested in implementing a summer program which is a branch of the G.R.E.A.T. Program. This summer program would be a partnership between the Department and the Boys and Girls Club.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of October, 2010 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

Conducted Shift Supervisor duties on many of my scheduled shifts.

Monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence assuring proper packaging and proper identification was affixed.

Managed the filling of open records requests for video evidence.

Filled video evidence requests from the District Attorney and City Attorney that were to be used in the prosecution of municipal or criminal cases.

Managed all schedule related issues for all sworn department members (comp, vacation, training, special assignment, and 2011 shift selections).

Attended an Administrative Staff Meeting with Chief Revels, Lieutenant Nicholson and Administrative Assistant Rhonda Culpitt.

Attended a meeting with Tomah High School representatives that included discussions about the School Resource Officer, upcoming events, and school safety.

Conducted cooperative scheduling with Probation and Parole for the purpose of having a Probation Agent ride with a police officer during the hours of Trick-or-Treat to conduct house visits with registered sex offenders residing in our jurisdiction.

Planned and supervised the police units involved with the Homecoming Parade.

Met with Officer Marshall regarding the implementation of the G.R.E.A.T. Program.

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of October, 2010 by Lieutenant Mark Nicholson:

I completed Evidence Custodian Duties related to the recovery, retention, and disposal of evidence. For the month of October, seventy-seven pieces of evidence were processed into the evidence room.

I reviewed Field Training Officer paperwork and processes relative to Probationary Officer Helgerson. On October 14, 2010, a Probationary Review Board was held. Upon the recommendation of the Review Board Officer Helgerson advanced to Phase 2, Step 5. Officer Helgerson will be assigned to solo patrol for the remainder of her field training program.

On October 26th, I attended the Domestic Abuse Violence event held at the Tomah Police Department. Along with members of the community, the event

was attended by members of the Rotary Club of Tomah, The Interact Club, Brighter Tomorrows and the Monroe County District Attorney's Office.

On October 28th, I attended a candlelight vigil sponsored by Brighter Tomorrows. The event was a community celebration supporting the victims of domestic violence. Officer Kenworthy was recognized during the event for the work he has done and the assistance he has provided to Brighter Tomorrows while investigating cases of domestic violence.

TRAINING

Officer Furlano attended Crisis Intervention Training.

Lieutenant Charles Berard provided a four hour block of instruction on Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs. Lieutenant Berard was here as a representative of the Wisconsin Chapter of the Motorcycle Gang Intelligence Association.

The Combined Tactical Unit trained on issues related to tactical medicine, self-aid and officer down rescues.

Sergeant Holum and Officer Kenworthy attended grant writing training at Volk Field.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Police Department, the Rotary Club of Tomah, Interact, Brighter Tomorrows, and the District Attorney's Office organized a Domestic Violence Awareness event that was held on October 26th. Approximately third-five people attended the event.

INVESTIGATIONS

10-2080] Possession of Marijuana/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
Tomah Officers assisted the Wisconsin Department of Justice with a search warrant in the City of Tomah. The search warrant resulted in one subject being arrested for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The subject was issued citations for the drug offenses and taken to Monroe County Jail for felony charges related to the search warrant that was executed by the Wisconsin Department of Justice.

[10-2086] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated/Unreasonable and Imprudent Speed

A Tomah Officer observed a vehicle speeding as well as swerving from its designated lane of travel. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was asked to submit to Field Sobriety Tests. The driver refused to take the tests but did submit to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .211 BAC. The driver was

processed for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated and ultimately transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-2093] Disorderly Conduct/Criminal Damage to Property

Tomah Officers observed a subject in the downtown bar district that appeared agitated and upset. This subject was contacted and Officers noted that the subject's hand was swollen, cut and bleeding. Another subject approached the Officers and indicated he was a victim and that the subject the Police were talking with had created a disturbance and also punched the windshield of the victim's car causing it to break. The subject was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related and Criminal Damage to Property with a restitution request for \$300.

[10-2099] Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol related-Physical

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the American Legion for a physical altercation between two male subjects. Officers arrived on scene and spoke with both involved parties. Based on information provided by the subjects involved it was determined that one of them had initiated physical contact with the other by shoving him off a bar stool. The victim received a small cut to his ear and wished to file a complaint with the Police. The subject who shoved the victim was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct-Alcohol Related-Physical with a bond amount of \$1,000.

[10-2126] Violation of Closing Hours

Tomah Officers observed the back door to The Carlton Supper Club open. Further investigation ultimately revealed that the bar owner had patrons in the establishment past bar closing times. During the initial investigation the new bar owner provided false information to the Police. Also during the Police contact, and subsequent investigation, the wife of the bar owner escorted two male subjects to an apartment above the bar; this was done in an attempt to avoid having the Police find them in the bar after hours. The bar owner was cited for Violation of Closing Hours and released.

[10-2186] Battery to School Officials (Felony), Attempted Battery to Law Enforcement (Felony), Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the Tomah High School for a reported disorderly student. Upon arrival Officers located staff members struggling with a male student. The male student was restrained by school officials as well as Tomah Officers. During the struggle the male student kicked a teacher and attempted to bite a Police Officer. The student was taken into custody and transported to a secure juvenile detention center in La Crosse, WI.

[10-2226] Disorderly Conduct – Alcohol Related

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the Bank Bar for a report that a male subject had brandished a knife during an altercation. Upon arrival Officers determined that a male subject was being disorderly and when asked to leave the bar pulled

a knife on a patron and the bar tender. The subject was located and taken into custody.

[10-2246] Attempted Battery to Law Enforcement (Felony)/Disorderly Conduct – Physical/alcohol related

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Brahma's Bar for a reported disturbance involving a female subject. This female subject was located and she attempted to leave the area. The female subject was issued a municipal citation for Disorderly Conduct – Physical/Alcohol (\$1,000.00). When the female was given the citation she crumpled it up and threw it in the face of the issuing Officer. The female then, without delay, lunged at the Officer and tried to strike the Officer in the face with her hand. The female subject was controlled with an Electronic Control Device and taken into custody without further incident. The female subject was transported to the Monroe County Jail.

[10-2260] Aggravated Battery (Felony)/Disorderly Conduct

Tomah Officers were dispatched to the Break Room Bar for a fight in progress. Officers were informed that a fight had occurred in the alley behind the bar. Officers arrived on scene and located a male subject who was bleeding profusely from the mouth and was also spitting teeth out into his hand. The subject was the victim and was taken to Tomah Memorial Hospital for treatment. The suspect had fled prior to Police arrival but had been identified by three people, including the victim. The victim suffered several broken teeth and the victim's jaw was broken in two locations. The suspect had been contacted and stated he would turn himself into the Police on 10-25-10.

COMMENDATIONS

Thanks to Sergeant Scott Holum and Lieutenant Mark Nicholson for the work that they put into writing the Office of Justice Assistance Grant for the Nuisance Abatement Program.
