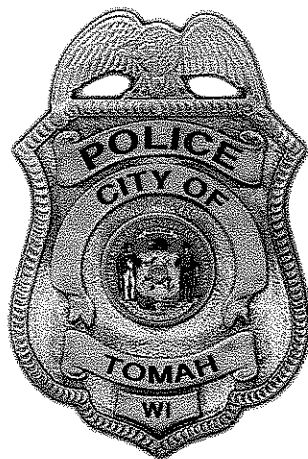

Training:

09/07/11:

Training was conducted at the Tomah Police Department firearms range and was conducted by Sgt. Pedersen. Training consisted of various firearms drills including shooting while moving, static turns and multiple targets. Accuracy was stressed during the training and I'm very pleased that a small number of rounds (less than 10) of all rounds fired by all personnel were outside of a 8 ½" x 11" piece of paper on the target chest. Training concluded with two competitive courses of fire that were scored based on time and accuracy.

09/21/11:

Training was conducted at the Monroe County Sheriff's Department firearms range and was conducted by Sgt. Pedersen. Training consisted of various firearms drills including shooting with partners. Training was conducted in the evening so officers had the opportunity to train in light, low-light and dark conditions. Targets used for this training were all hostage targets that made the training quite challenging.

Upon completing the range portion of training we moved to the Sparta Police Department and cleaned our chemical agent protective masks as a group. These masks were developing a film on the viewing portion that was easily removed with a cleaning solvent.

CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

INVESTIGATIONS

[11-1577] **Possession of Marijuana with Intent, Manufacture, Deliver, Distribute Marijuana, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, OMVWI-Restricted Substance, Underage Possession of Alcohol**

Tomah Officers received information from Juneau County of a vehicle that was involved in a gas drive-off. The vehicle was located and stopped near the BP Gas Station on E. Clifton St. During the traffic stop Officers observed the front seat passenger and a rear seat passenger trying to frantically push items under the front passenger seat. Officer could smell the odor of burnt marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The vehicle operator admitted to smoking a marijuana cigarette. Officers conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and located 26 grams of marijuana, a digital scale, rolling papers and other items of drug paraphernalia. Officers seized \$380 after receiving information that some of the money was from the selling of the marijuana.

[11-1636] Bail Jumping-Felony, Resisting Arrest, Escape, Obstructing an Officer, Theft

Tomah Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that drove through the grassy area near Kwik Trip North. During the investigation the vehicle operator provided Officers with a false name. Tomah Officers were able to determine that the name the operator gave was false. When the operator realized the Officers knew he was providing a false name he fled on foot. Tomah Officers were able to control the fleeing suspect with the use of an Electronic Control Device. The suspect was eventually identified and determined to be on several sets of bond conditions. The suspect was taken to jail.

[11-1683] Disorderly Conduct-Municipal

Tomah Police Department personnel and an underage person conducted Alcohol License Compliance Checks on 09/16/11. During compliance check at the Elbow Room tavern the owner confronted the underage person who was assisting police and was disorderly. This incident and subsequent interview with the owner was audio and video recorded. The owner of the tavern was cited for Disorderly Conduct.

[11-1745] Substantial Battery, Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing an Officer

Tomah Officers were dispatched to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a battery complaint. Officers arrived and met with the victim and a witness. The victim could not recall what took place. The witness stated they were at Gillett Park and the victim was confronted by a male subject. The male subject punched the victim in the head twice knocking the victim unconscious. The suspect kicked the victim off the picnic table. The suspect then climbed on top of the picnic table, jumped in the air and delivered a flying elbow strike to the rib cage of the victim. The suspect was located and admitted to being involved in the

battery. The suspect is a juvenile and charges will be referred to Monroe County Human Services.
