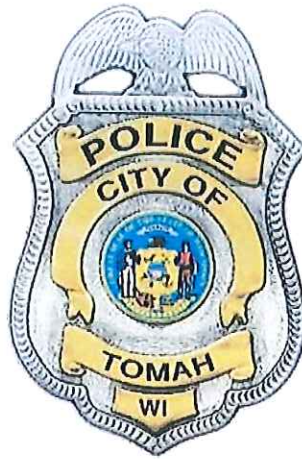

September 2014 Report

CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of September 2014:

I addressed the Tomah High School Student body during an assembly which was held the first day of school.

I attended the Combined Tactical Unit quarterly meeting with Lt. Kuderer and Sheriff Quirin.

I attended and facilitated the Swearing In Ceremony for Officer Nicholas Gimson.

I attended and facilitated an Administrative Staff Meeting.

At the request of Mayor Hough I met with her and a citizen in reference to a complaint that was filed through her office.

I attended both the Committee of the Whole and the City Council monthly meetings.

I attended the Monroe County Safe Community Coalition quarterly meeting.

I attended the Monroe County Investigative Task Force quarterly meeting with Lt. Kuderer and Sheriff Quirin.

I attended the Our Town Tomah monthly meeting.

I met with the last of the Licensed Agents who failed their quarterly compliance checks.

I attended a "Town Hall" style meeting held at the Veterans Affairs Hospital.

I assisted in the facilitation of the departments Social Media Networks.

I assisted in the weekly monitoring of the Prescription Drug Drop Off Box located in the lobby of the Tomah Police Department.

I attended bi-weekly meetings with other City of Tomah Department Supervisors.

I met with Police and Fire Commission Chair Larry Baribeau in reference to various department matters.

During the half-time of a Tomah High School Varsity football game I participated in the Teresa Williams Diva Dash. The other six participants and myself were

able to raise approximately \$3,500 which was donated to the Brighter Tomorrows Domestic Abuse Program.

OPERATIONS LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out in the month of September 2014 by Lieutenant Ron Waddell:

All scheduling responsibilities (time off, overtime, special events, etc.)

Facilitated responsibilities as the Time Agency Coordinator (TAC), scheduling on-line recertification and conducting expiration audits

I conducted shift supervisor activities on many of my regularly scheduled shifts and was available for incident command/high risk calls

I assist with incoming temporary evidence as needed. The evidence responsibilities also required return of evidence and limited destruction of evidence as time permitted. Evidence was provided to officers for follow-up and/or turn over to other police agencies.

Plan and organize resources for upcoming Tomah Homecoming Parade

Met with race director for Remembering Teresa Run/Walk/Duathlon, which will take place October 4, 2014, starting at the High School. The department annually assists with race course and traffic planning.

At the direction of the Chief, I have entered into discussions with a new organization (WISCOPS) for the purpose of starting an eligibility list for new officer candidates. WISCOPS has the following mission statement: **"The mission of WisCOPS LLC is to improve the quality of public safety in Wisconsin by providing candidates and public safety agencies with candidate screening services that reduce costs and improve the process experienced by the candidate and agency."**

I participated in a discussion with regarding Officer Tyler Franks advancement to Step 5 (Solo Patrol)

SUPPORT SERVICES LIEUTENANT ACTIVITIES

The following is a list of tasks/assignments/responsibilities carried out by Lieutenant Scott Holum in the month of September 2014:

I conducted Shift Supervisor responsibilities on most of my shifts.

I monitored the Prescription Drug Box in the front lobby of the police department.

I monitored and processed incoming temporary evidence as needed. Lieutenant Waddell and Sergeant Preuss assist with this as well.

I provided oversight to Sergeant Huneck concerning the Fleet Maintenance program with scheduled and unscheduled repairs.

I attended an Administrative Meeting.

I assisted Lt. Waddell in scheduling related matters.

I ordered new ID cards for sworn and non-sworn employees.

I researched, developed and implemented a voluntary drug testing program through TestMyTeen.com that allows parents to obtain a free drug test kit to assist them with keeping their children off of drugs.

I attended TIME Agency Coordinator training in Vernon County.

TRAINING:

Training was conducted in Tomah and consisted of firearms training at the TPD range and some building clearing exercises at Miller Elementary School. Firearms training consisted of checking weapons zeros and then training with both pistol and rifle and ended with some live fire threshold assessments (including two officer) using the breaching door from the VA Police. After break training continued at Miller Elementary School with a debrief on the Headquarters Rd. Callout and then building clearing walk through exercises using some techniques from the new WI DOJ Tactical Response curriculum.

Sparta Police Department assigned another officer to CTU, Officer Corey Johnson was interviewed by the CTU command personnel and welcomed to the team. This brings Sparta Police to five officers assigned. Tomah Police have five personnel assigned and currently Monroe County Sheriff has four personnel assigned with hopefully another deputy assigned within the next several months. The CTU Memorandum of

Understanding requires that each host agency (Monroe County Sheriff, Sparta Police and Tomah Police) have a minimum of four personnel assigned.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

Sept 2

Student walked away from the building twice and was returned by myself. After returning the second time we were meeting with the student in the office. The student became agitated and ran down the hallway yelling obscenities and attempting to get into classrooms. I took the student into custody. The student was later transported to the police department and released to mother. Student also received a citation for Disorderly Conduct.

Follow up phone call with Social Worker from Monroe County Human Services in regards to the harassment/threat complaint the previous week.

Assisted at Tomah Middle School with bus transfers for the first day.

Spoke with a student in regards to the status of their open citations.

Sept 3

Assisted with gas line break by Miller School.

Accident with school vehicle in Tomah High School parking lot.

Assisted Sgt. Huneck with interview of a student responsible for damage to property.

Spoke with a student in regards to their behavior and what they are posting on Facebook.

Threat assessment completed on student from the previous day.

Sept 4

Spoke with a parent in regards to their 18 year old student dating a 16 year old.

Supplemental report in regards to Damage to Property and citation service. Reference case 14-1245

Sept 5

Attempted follow up in regards to students who have not been riding the bus. Appears as though the students are still making it to school. Business card given to one of the students to provide to their guardian.

Served a citation to a student I was not able to locate at home.

Identified a pill found in the hallway as an allergy medication.

Sept 8

Contact with a student having anxiety/behavior issues twice today.

Patrol officers dealt with a student who refused to attend school and left residence. Unable to locate the student.

Follow up with Monroe County Humane Officer reference a concern about horses.

Talked with Monroe County Human Services Social Worker in regards to follow up on a student concern. Student has now relocated out of the area.

Responded to Lemonweir School in regards to a student who ran away from the school.

Concern about a Tomah Middle School student.

Sept 9

Assisted with a medical concern in regards to a student with an injured leg. Ambulance transported student to Tomah Memorial Hospital.

Picked up barricades for the Tomah High School and Tomah Middle School.

At a parent's request I spoke with a Tomah Middle School student in regards to being afraid of someone and calling 911 if they see the person they are afraid of.

Sept 10

Report of an incident that occurred on the school bus.

Tomah Middle School student caused damaged to a door . Parent advised and picked up the child.

Attended Pupil Services Meeting.

Discussed concerns in regards to a special education student.

Addressed student concerns in which one student reported being hit by another.

Follow up with injured student from the day before. Injury not as serious as student portrayed it.

Met with a parent who had concerns about their student's attendance issues.

Report of a stolen cell phone.

Sept 11

Recovered stolen cell phone. Later completed the report.

Student to be cited for Truancy. Report completed.

Information received about living conditions of student claiming to not have electricity and water at home.

Information received in regards to a student making threats at Tomah Middle School.

Met with a student and family about Facebook harassment. Suspect was later talked to about the matter.

Sept 12

Meeting with Tomah Middle School staff in regards to student making threats the previous day.

Traffic complaints from staff members. Students were counseled.

Report of a harassment complaint. Suspect counseled.

Follow up with student reporting harassment the previous day.

Cited a student for Truancy after they refused to attend school.

Served citation to student for Truancy the previous day.

Follow up with stolen phone matter from earlier in the week.

Concern about where a family with multiple students, in multiple schools should go after school since the study center was closed. Contact eventually made with a family member who was advised students were sent home on the bus.

Sept 15

Received a complaint from a parent about a student having sexual relations with an adult student.

Assisted at Miller School reference a report of a student that fled the building. Student was found hiding in the building.

Made arrangements for the CTU to use a school building for training.

Discussed student issues with Principal at Robert Kupper Learning Center.

Watched over a student who was refusing to follow staff directives. Student eventually went to class.

Sept 16

Student ran away from Tomah Middle School. Student was located and escorted back to school.

Assisted Monroe County Human Services with an interview.

Report from a parent that their student was receiving text messages soliciting their child for pictures. Referred to Investigator.

Student walked away from Tomah High School. Unable to locate the student and parent notified.

Arrested student for Sexual Assault.

Sept 17

Completed sexual assault report.

Follow up with student in regards to Child Enticement case that Investigator is working on.

Follow up interviews in regards to sexual assault.

Traffic complaint about students at lunch. Follow up with students and their parents.

Parking complaint.

Sept 18

Follow up with student in regards to truancy issues and harassment of another student.

Met with a student and parent in regards to harassment.

Spoke with subject in regards to military back ground check.

Spoke with a Principal at elementary school in regards to multiple concerns.

Spoke with JAG instructor about student concerns.

Spoke with special education teacher in regards to student concerns.

Received a traffic complaint.

Advised of special education student who accidently brought a knife to school. School administration handled the matter.

Sept 19

Follow up completed reference a traffic complaint.

Installed a car seat for family at Tomah Memorial Hospital.

Spoke with Monroe County Human Services in regards to neglect concerns of a student. Student doesn't have running water or electricity at home.

Spoke with the Monroe County Health Department reference getting a car seat for someone in need.

Spoke with staff member and school social worker in regard to a special needs student and their current placement and dealing with student.

Spoke with an individual in regards to an elderly subject driving that they want to stop from driving.

Spoke with an elementary student in regards to images on their cell phone that was reported to be inappropriate. Unfounded and students parent was advised.

Sept 22

Pupil services meeting.

Dealt with a student refusing to attend class. Parent came and picked up student.

Concern about a Tomah High School student sending inappropriate pictures to other students. Multiple students talked to about the matter.

Concerns about an elementary student making threatening comments and statements on the bus. Matter referred to the Monroe County Sheriff's Department and Monroe County Human Services. Group meeting with parents, school staff, Monroe County Human Services, Monroe County Sheriff's Deputy and myself.

Sept 23

Parent concern of a female student stalking an ex-boyfriend and contacting students in regards to the ex-boyfriend. Numerous students talked to about the matter and suspect student advised to stop the activity.

Concerns about a student cutting on their arms. Guidance counselor advised parent who took follow up action.

Information received of a student who gave another student some sort of over-the-counter medication and claimed it was Vicodin.

Spoke with a parent in regards to student concerns in regards to depression and truancy.

Spoke with Pupil Services Director about miscellaneous student concerns.

Spoke with a student complaining of harassment by other students. All students counseled about the matter.

Spoke with Assistant Principal at Tomah Middle School in regards to student truancy concerns.

Sept 24

Returned property to a student that was found the previous evening.

Spoke with school social worker about a student with depression and truancy issues.

Spoke with guidance counselor about concerns she had with a student who was cutting.

Received information from ISP workers about drug dealings.

Spoke with Monroe County Human Services social worker about multiple student concerns.

Dealt with a 5 year old and transportation issue. Parent was advised of the concerns.

INVESTIGATIONS

[14-1326] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated

A Tomah officer conducted a traffic stop for suspicion that the operator was impaired. The officer administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and established probable cause to arrest the driver. A Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) was administered and the result was .131, confirming the officer's suspicion that the driver was impaired due to alcohol. The driver was arrested and transported to the Tomah Police Department for processing. The driver was released to a responsible party.

[14-1330] Strangulation and Suffocation, Battery, Disorderly Conduct

Tomah officers were dispatched to an address on the 900 block of Grandview Avenue for a report of a female yelling that she couldn't breathe. Officers arrived and learned that a male subject had choked his girlfriend during an argument. The male subject was arrested and taken to jail. The female didn't require medical attention.

[14-1341] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Impaired/Drugged

Tomah officers were dispatched to Casey's General Store after an employee called and indicated there was a possibly intoxicated male subject who had a small child in his vehicle. Officers arrived and located a vehicle with a male in the driver seat and small child in the backseat. Officers had contact with the male subject a couple weeks prior after the male subject had overdosed on Vicodin. The driver was unable to keep his eyes open and couldn't comprehend simple instructions. Officers established probable cause to arrest the driver. The driver was transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a legal blood draw. The driver was not under the influence of alcohol. The driver was transported to jail. The child was released to its mother.

[14-1354] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-4th Offense, Open Intoxicant in Motor Vehicle

Tomah officers responded to Brenengen's car dealership for a possible intoxicated subject who had arrived to have a vehicle serviced. Officers arrived and met with a male subject who was in the process of dumping out a bottle of alcohol. Officers were familiar with the subject from prior Police contacts. The officer administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and established probable cause to arrest the driver. A Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) was administered and the result was .159, confirming the officer's suspicion that the driver was impaired due to alcohol. The driver was transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital for a legal blood draw and then taken to jail.

[14-1359] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated, Underage Alcohol Consumption

A Tomah officer conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer smelled the odor of intoxicants and observed alcohol in the vehicle. The officer verified the driver was under the age of 21. The officer administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and established probable cause to arrest the

driver. A Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) was administered and the result was .200, confirming the officer's suspicion that the driver was impaired due to alcohol. The driver was processed at the Tomah Police Department and released to a responsible party.

[14-1360] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-2nd Offense

A Tomah officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation. Upon contact with the driver, the officer smelled the odor of intoxicants and observed other signs of impairment. The officer administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) and established probable cause to arrest the driver. A Preliminary Breath Test (PBT) was administered and the result was .224, confirming the officer's suspicion that the driver was impaired due to alcohol. The driver was processed at the Tomah Police Department and released to a responsible party.
