CRIME PREVENTION/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

The Department worked with Brittany Linenberg from the Tomah Journal to provide information to the community on the Department Facebook page, Department Website, the Drug Awareness Forum, Synthetic Marijuana and Balt Salts.

The Department held a Drug Awareness Forum in partnership with Coulee Cap, the Monroe County Safety Coalition and funded by the Drug Free Community Grant. Approximately eighty people attended.

INVESTIGATIONS

[12-0350] Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-4th offense (Felony), Probation and Parole Hold

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for operating without the headlamps on. The vehicle operator admitted to consuming alcohol and was subsequently administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The vehicle operator had three prior convictions for Operating While Intoxicated. The vehicle operator submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test and the result was .101 BAC. The vehicle operator is only permitted to have a Blood Alcohol Concentration of .02 due to the three previous convictions. The operator was taken into custody and transported to Tomah Memorial Hospital for processing. The vehicle operator was eventually transported to the Monroe County Jail and booked for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated and a Probation and Parole hold.

[12-0351] Intoxicated use of a weapon, Obstructing an Officer, Bail Jumping

Tomah Officers responded to a report of a pedestrian who was struck by a vehicle in front of an address on Green Acres Ave. A witness reported that people carried an unconscious subject into the residence on Green Acres Avenue. Upon arrival the occupants refused to answer the door and speak with law enforcement. Police forced entry to the residence and contacted the occupants. The investigation revealed that the subject who was reportedly "struck" by a vehicle was riding on the back of a vehicle and fell off, suffering minor injuries. The property owner was in possession of a .44 magnum revolver when police entered and was found to be intoxicated. The property owner was arrested, transported to the Tomah Police Department for an Intoximeter breath test and was later released with a Misdemeanor Citation. The revolver was seized. The property owner's Blood Alcohol Concentration was .11.

[12-0361] Drugs-Possession with Intent, Drugs-Marijuana Delivery/Manufacture/Distribute, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Bail Jumping

Tomah Officers received information of drug use on the 100 block of West Monroe St. Officers conducted an investigation and determined that several people had been inside the residence and were smoking marijuana. Officers located marijuana and items of drug paraphernalia. Officers also located a couple subjects hiding in the basement. One of these subjects was charged with Possession with Intent and Delivery of Marijuana. This subject is currently on bond out of Monroe County and was charged with Bail Jumping (Felony).

[12-0379] Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Restricted Controlled Substance, Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia

A Tomah Officer conducted a traffic stop and during the traffic stop K-9 Jager was used to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle. K-9 Jager indicated a positive alert on the vehicle. A probable cause search was conducted on the vehicle and marijuana and drug paraphernalia were located inside the vehicle. The vehicle operator was arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle With a restricted Controlled Substance. A passenger was cited for possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.
