Update October 9, 2012

On October 8, 2012 Tomah Officers responded to 511 North Glendale, where two people were found deceased inside the residence.

The deceased were identified as Michael C. Bobak and Tracey L.E. Small. Bobak and Small were residents of this address along with two minor children.

The Tomah Police Department is conducting an investigation into the deaths of Bobak and Small. The Department is being assisted by the Wisconsin Department of Criminal Investigations, Wisconsin State Crime Lab, Wisconsin State Patrol, and the Monroe County Coroner along with the Monroe County District Attorney.

On October 9, 2012 autopsies were completed. The preliminary findings of the forensic examinations of the bodies were consistent with information discovered during the processing of the residence. The information/evidence found during the autopsy and search of the residence showed that there were no injuries as a result of blunt trauma, gun shots, sharp instrument or any other method that would have caused the death of Bobak and Small in a violent manner.

Toxicology results may provide answers, but are not expected to be available to law enforcement for several weeks.

At this time, the Department has no information related to this investigation that would cause concern for the safety of members of the community. If anyone has information related to this incident please call the Tomah Police Department at 608.374.7400.
